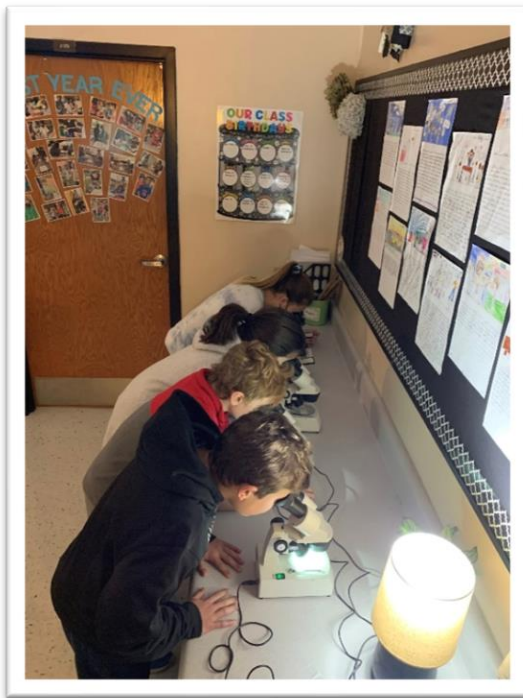


FOURTH GRADE EXPLORERS

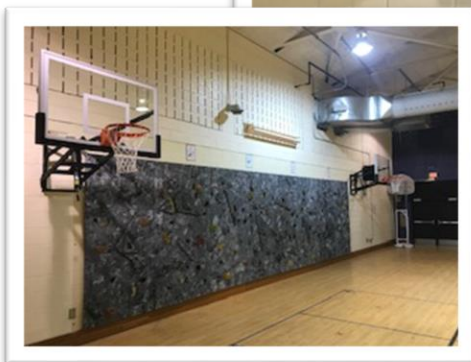
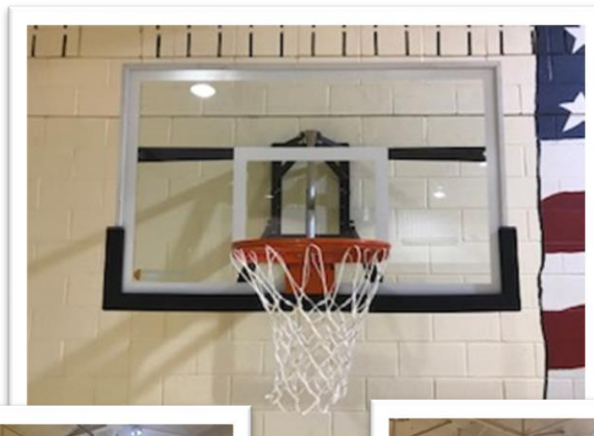

New Basketball Goals Are Here!

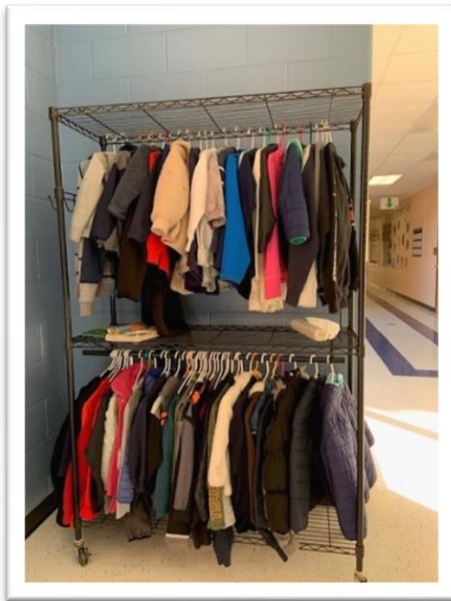

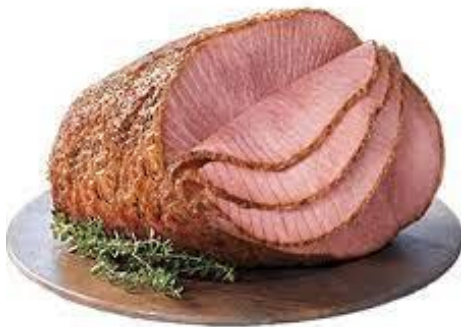
