



New Student Registration

New Student Registration Days for the 2022 – 2023 school year are Wednesday, March 9 and Thursday, March 10. Parents are encouraged to use the online enrollment application process to register online at their convenience. If your child is currently enrolled in Pre-K in Fulton County Schools, you do not need to register your child.

SGC Elections are coming soon. Parents we need you to stand for elections. We would love to partner with you on ways to improve our school.

The School Governance Council (SGC) has 1 parent/guardian position and 1 teacher position open for election. If elected, these candidates will serve for a period of two years. Parents or guardians of students who will be attending our school during **both** the 2022-2023 **and** 2023-2024 school years are eligible to run for the parent/guardian SGC positions.

- Candidate declaration phase begins on 02/02/2022 and ends on 03/02/2022 at 5:00 pm.
- Candidates who wish to run for re-elections should visit FCS charter system website on 02/02/2022. Click to access the Charter System (SGC) / Elections (fultonschools.org)

Eligibility Requirements for All Council Members

- May only serve on 1 School Governance Council at a time
- May NOT be an elected official of a government entity
- Must be the ONLY member of their family serving on the Council
- Must be 18 years of age or older (with the exception of high school student members)

Parents

- Must have a child enrolled at the school for the duration of the term they declare candidacy for
- May NOT be an employee of the school

Teachers

- May NOT be the parent of a child enrolled at the school
- Must be a school-based employee with a "home school"
- Must be paid from teacher salary schedule

School Employees

- MAY be the parent of a child enrolled at the school
- Must be a school-based employee with a "home school"

Community Members

- MAY be the parent of a child enrolled at the school
- May NOT be an employee of the school


