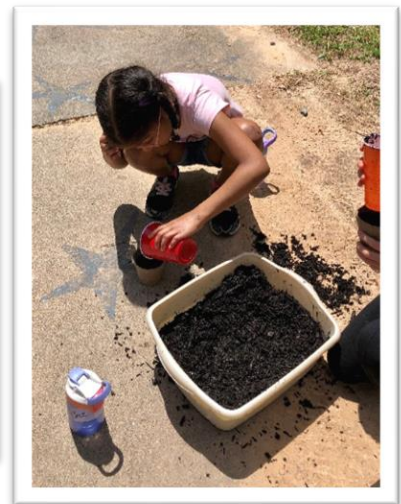

The End of the Year is Near

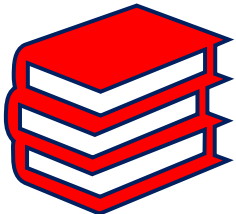

MEDICATION PICK UP

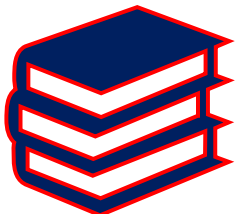

6. Proof of Residency- Required to provide One Current Utility Proof AND One Residence Proof
7. Academic Record (if applicable)
