The Nurse Officer will assist the Health Officer in providing medical assessment and treatment for all school communities at Jakarta Intercultural School.

- Valid license to practice as a registered nurse
- Minimum of 2-year experience within the last five years in school nursing

- Demonstrated effective human relation skills that include the ability to listen to and accept differing opinions, ability to manage and resolve conflict, and ability to respond tactfully

- Demonstrated effective written and verbal communication skills, both in English and Bahasa.
- Willing to work outside regular school hours or weekends.

## **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Provides medical assessment and treatment for all staff and students and also offers medical emergency treatment for all school community (drivers, security, nannies, cafeteria staff, parents, cleaner, and daily workers)
- Controls Immunization Records and contributes to tuberculosis screening and immunization, such as flu vaccines, hepatitis, typhoid, etc. for students, staff, and families
- Collaborates with parents to arrange daily and or emergency medications for students
- Provides assessment to students for vision, hearing, scoliosis, and conducts drug testing, then notifies staff and parents if there are any medical concerns.
- Provides first aid supplies and support for special events and standby 24 hours for the overnight field trip
- Consults and collaborates with parents, teachers, school administrators, and community health or social service agencies to address student health problems and plan health services
- Provides medical assistance standby for after school activities, collaborates with campus supervisor, community liaison, and coaches
- Keeps Inventory of nursing supplies and equipment
- Embraces the JIS Learning Dispositions of Resilience, Resourcefulness, Relating well with others, and Reflecting.
- Performs other related duties and assuming other responsibilities as assigned by the Health Officer, including, and not limited to participation in class/School's activities or events, attendance of workshops organized by JIS
