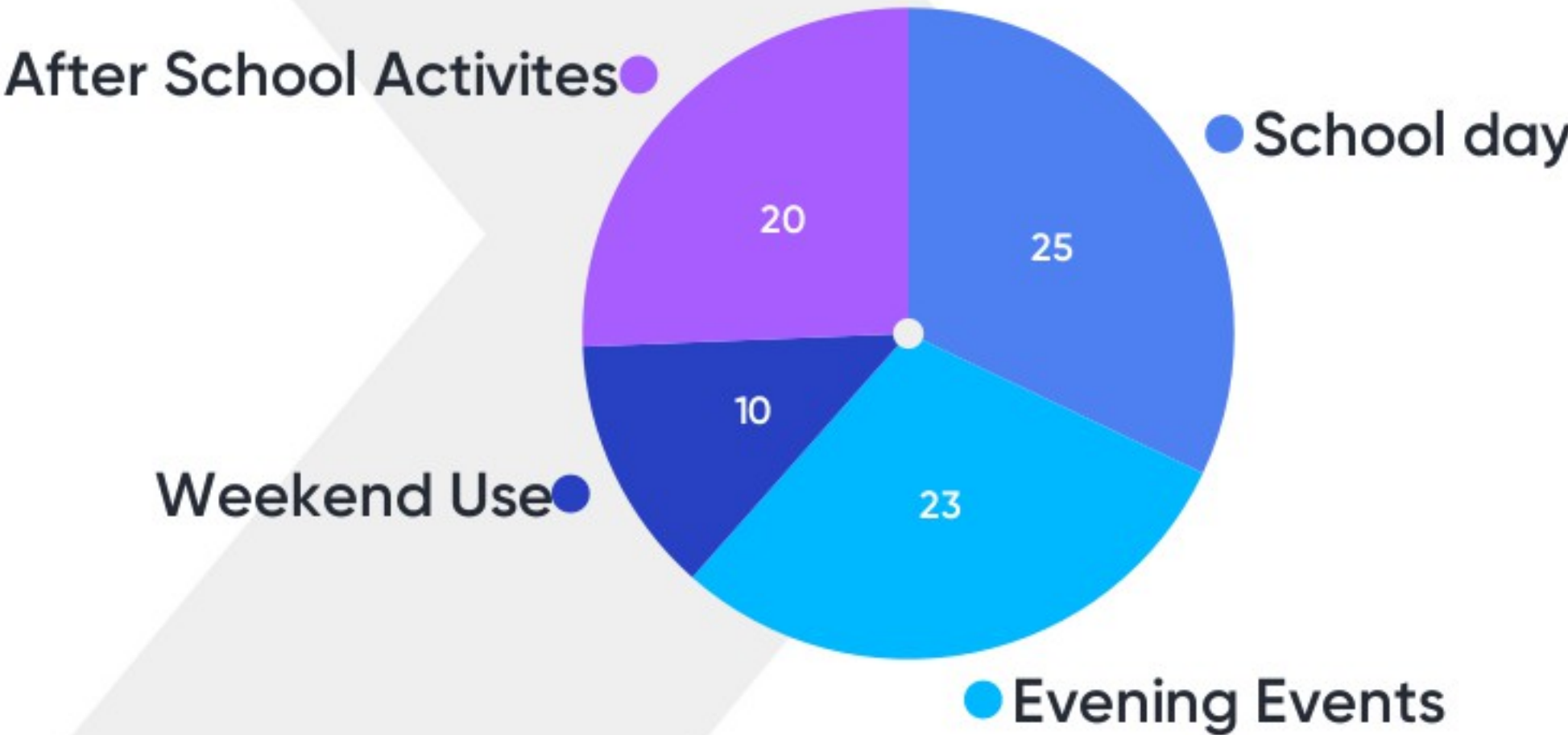

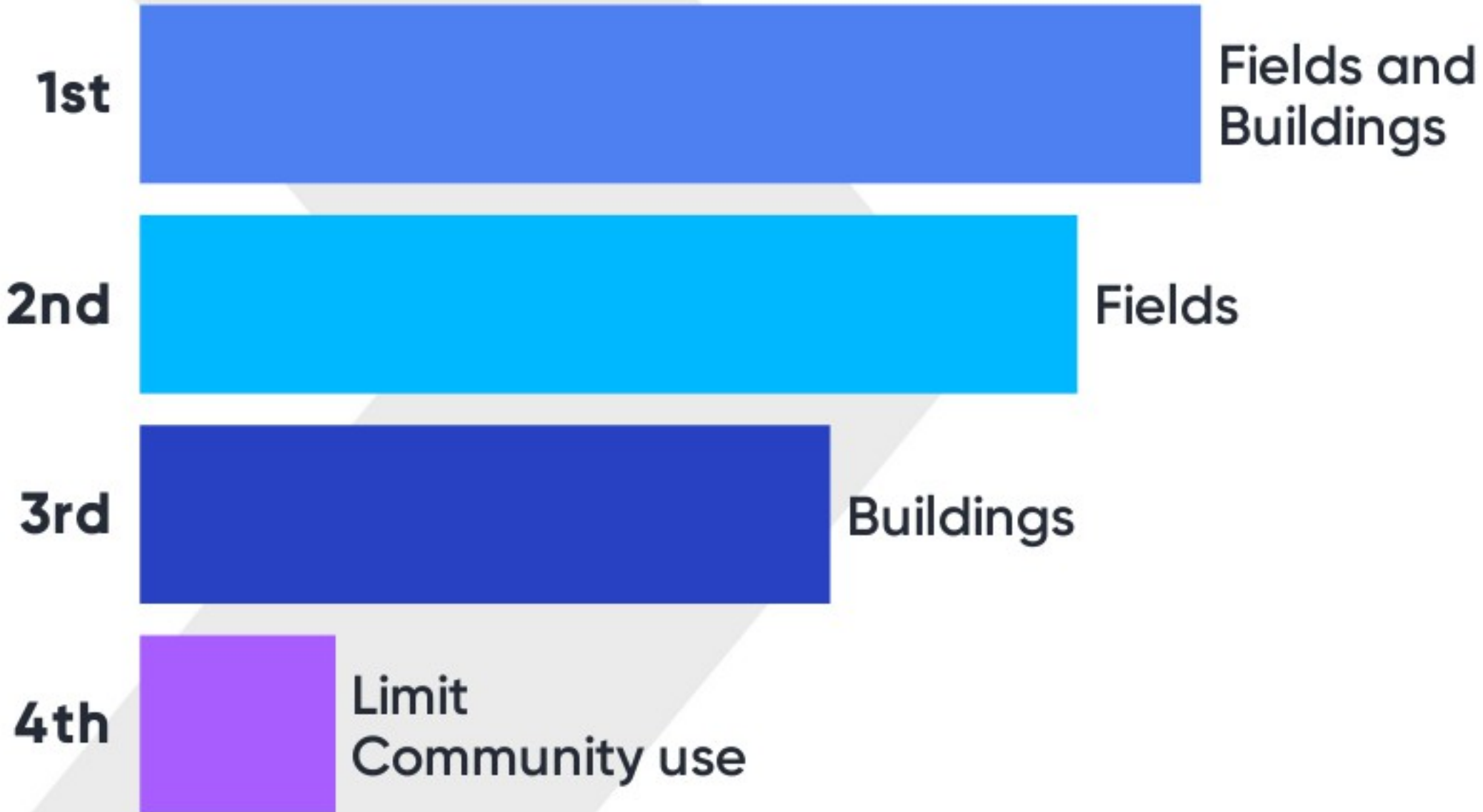

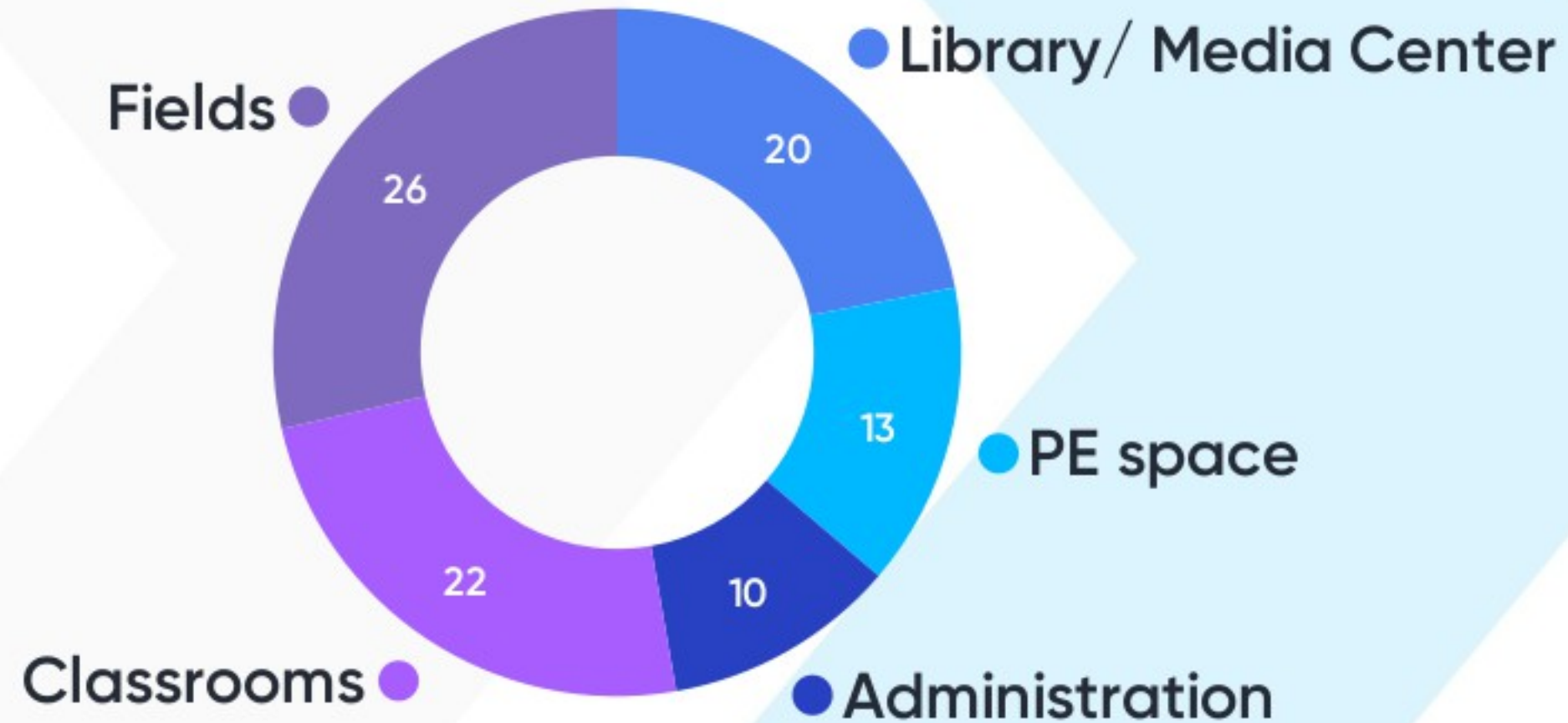

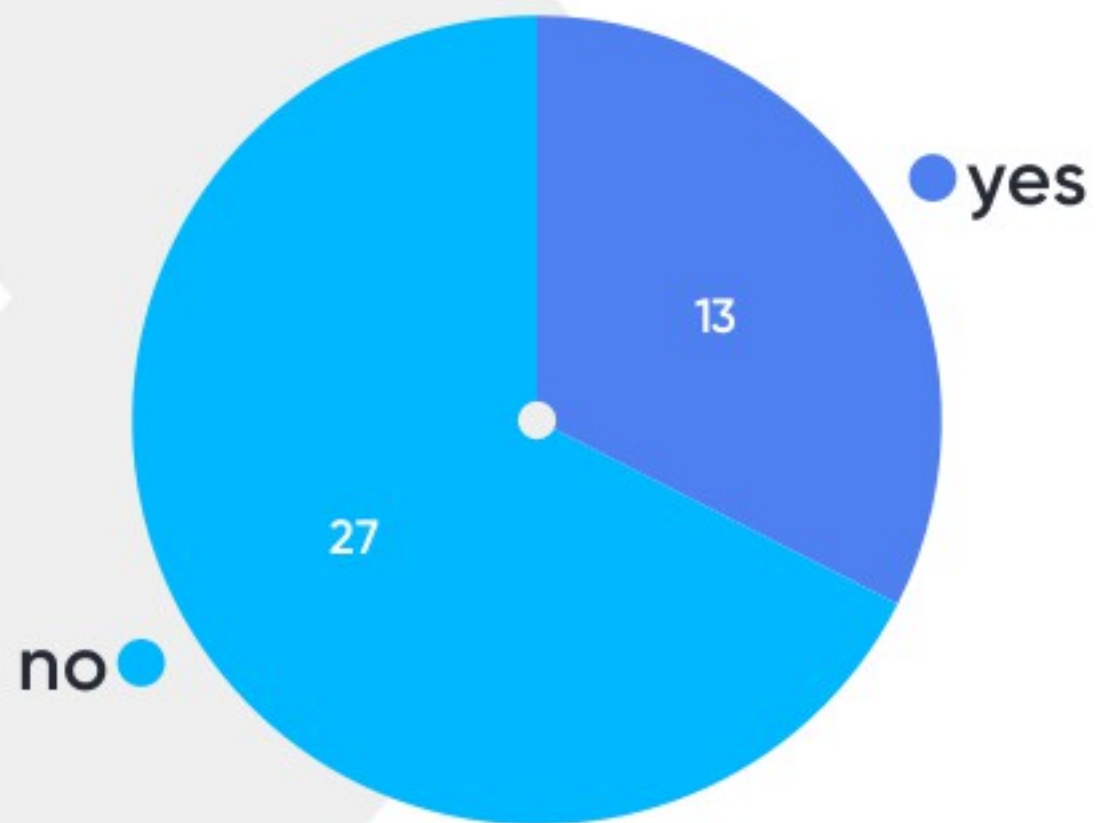

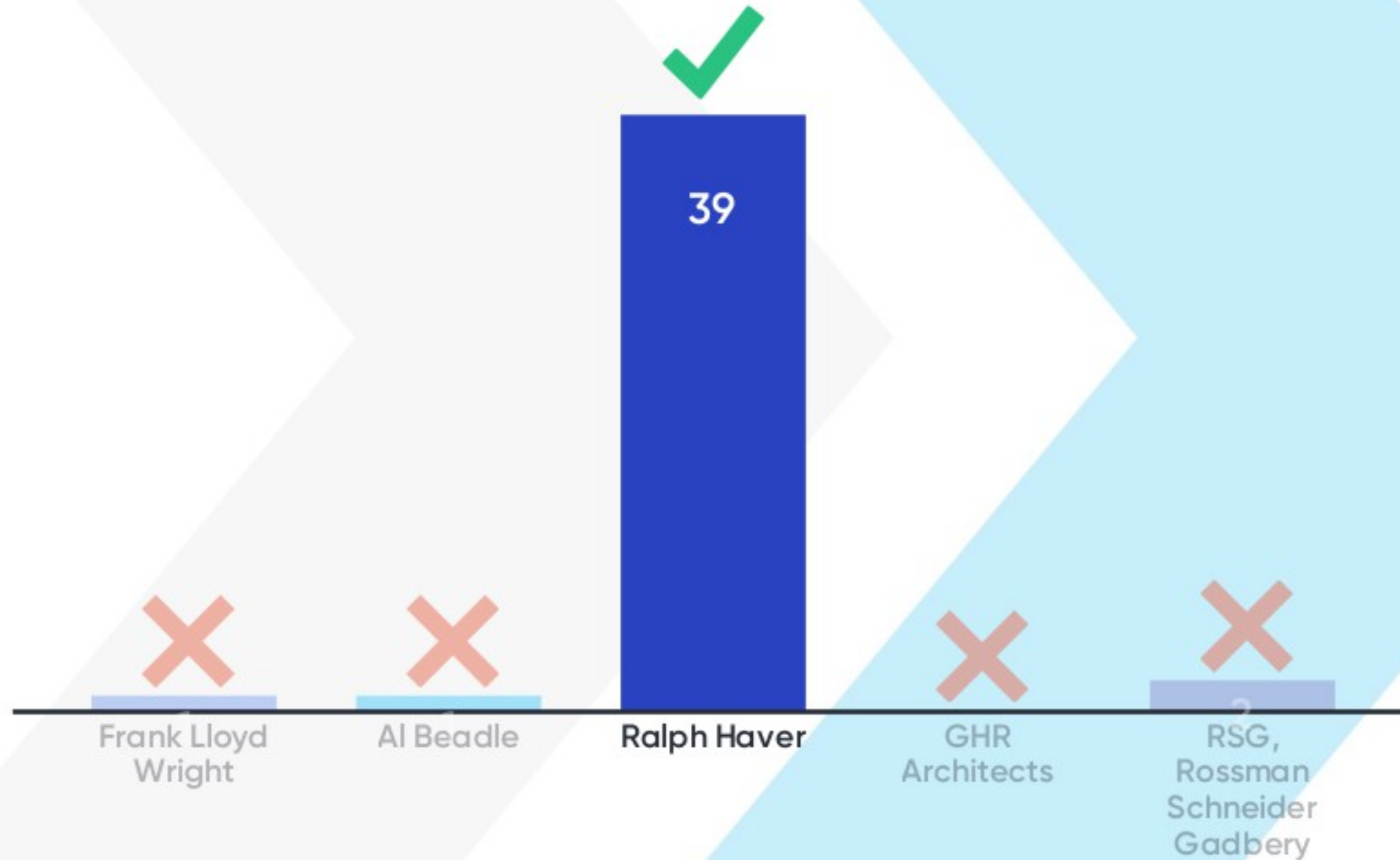

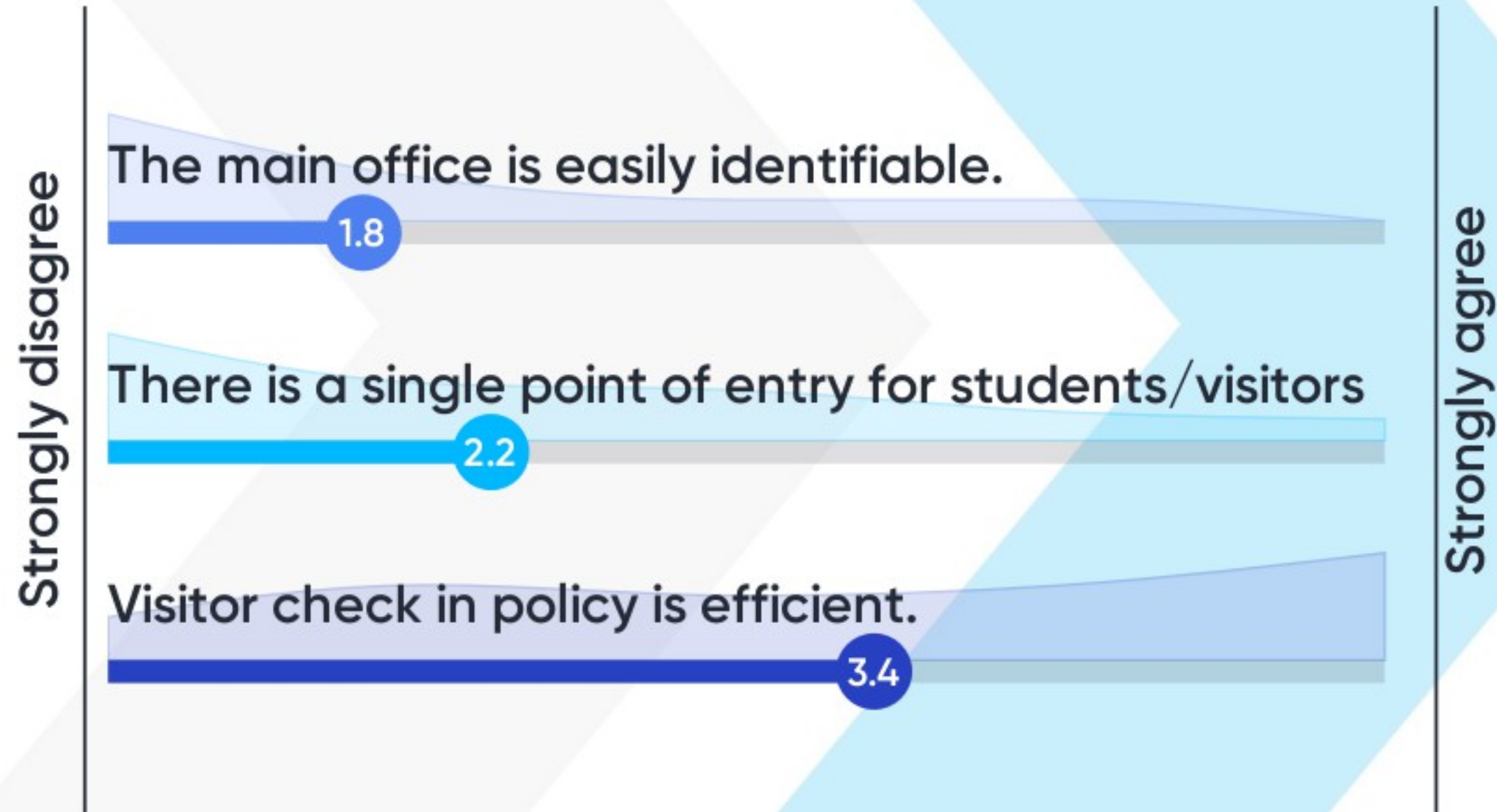

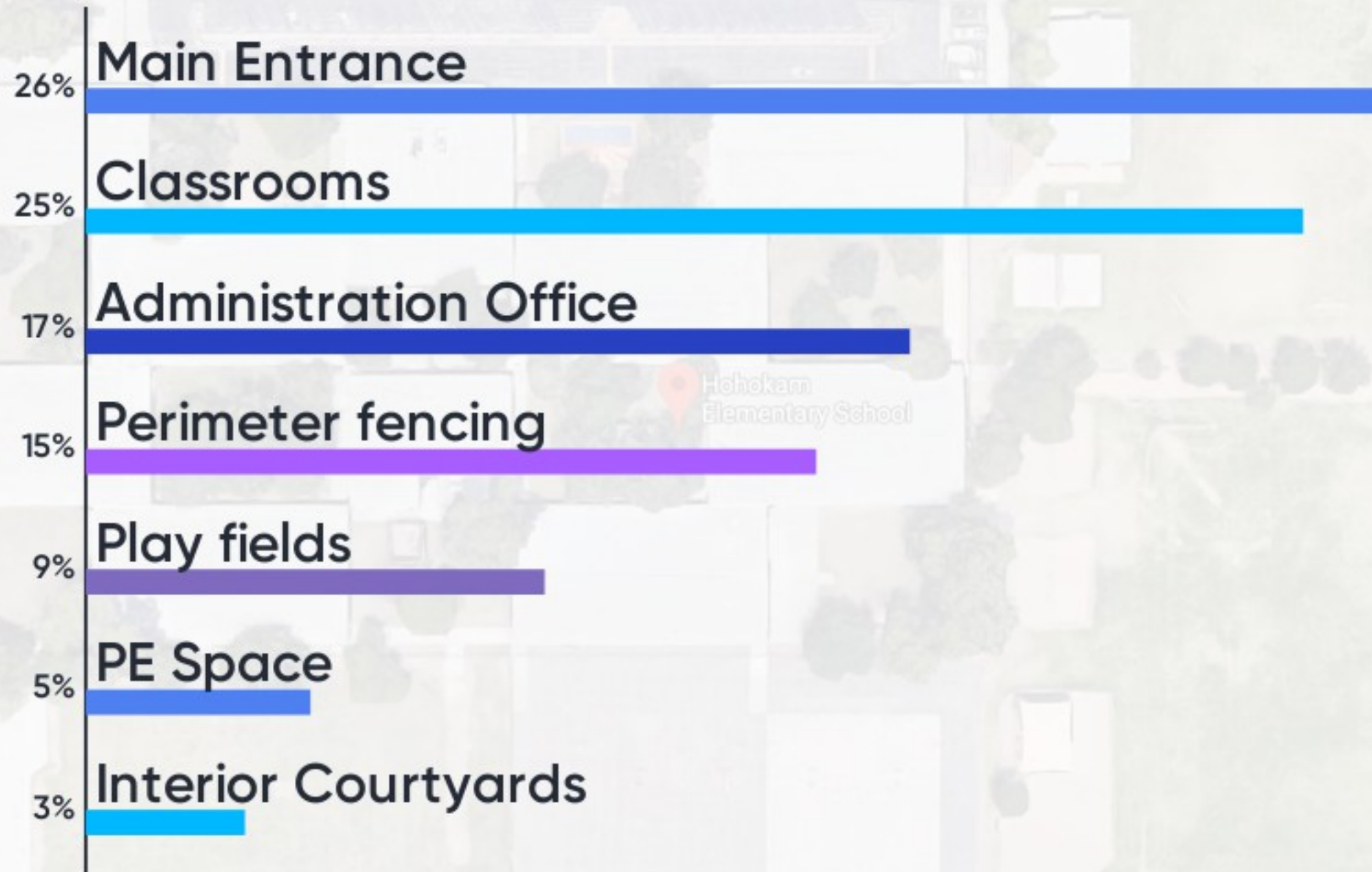
Best practices of campus security recommend a single point of entry. Does the current configuration meet this intent?



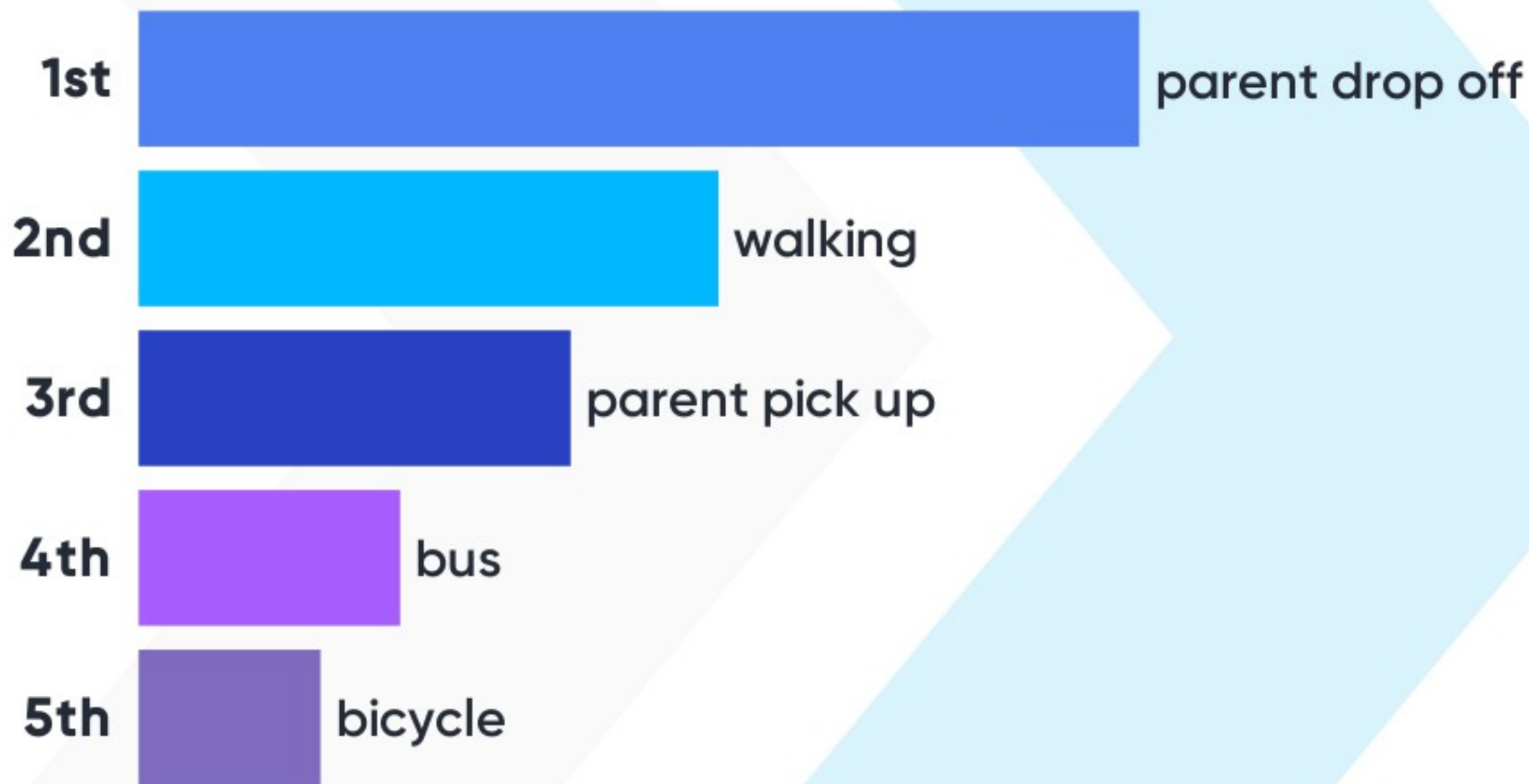

Most frequent use of transportation for your student to and from school is

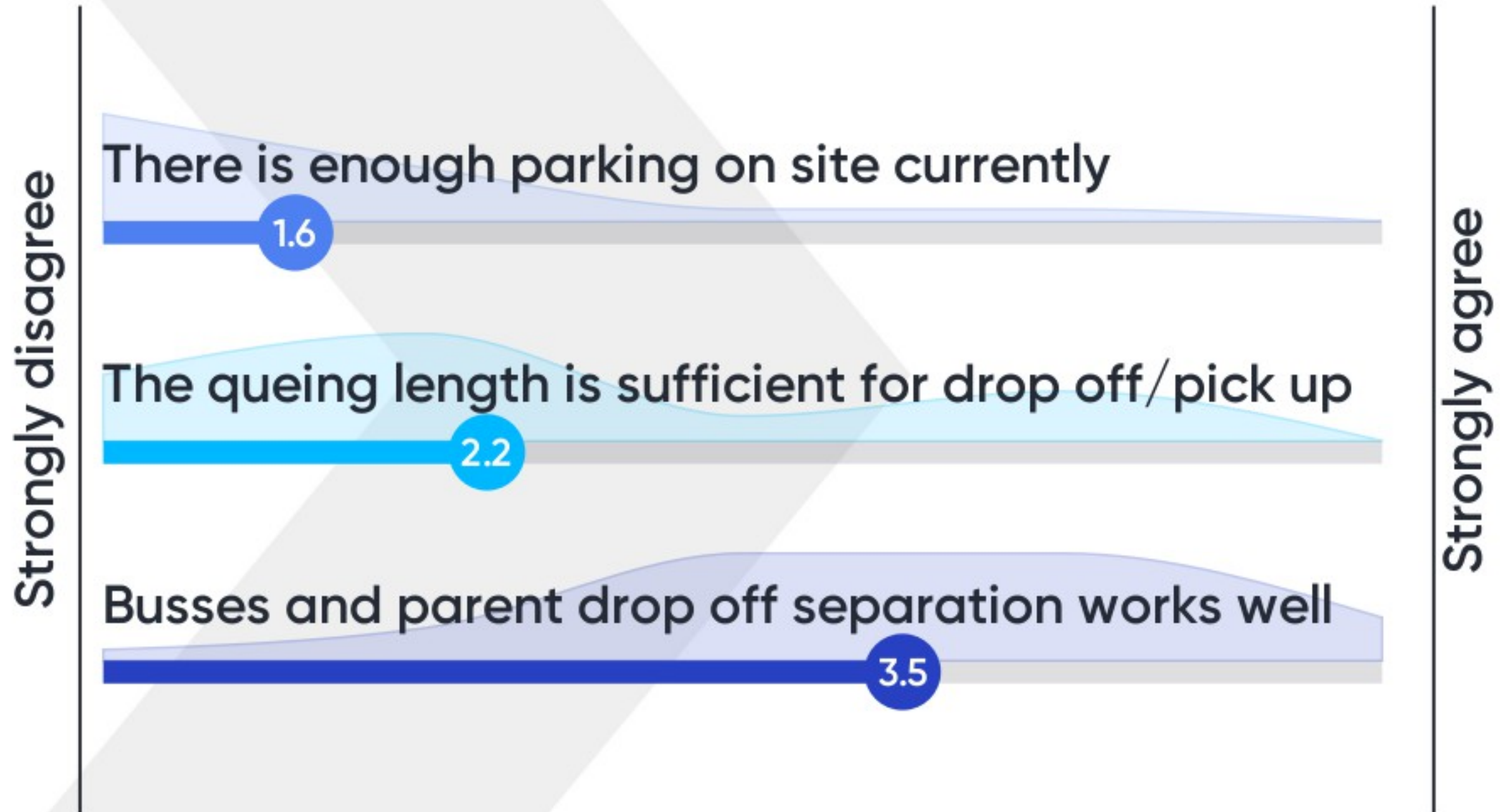

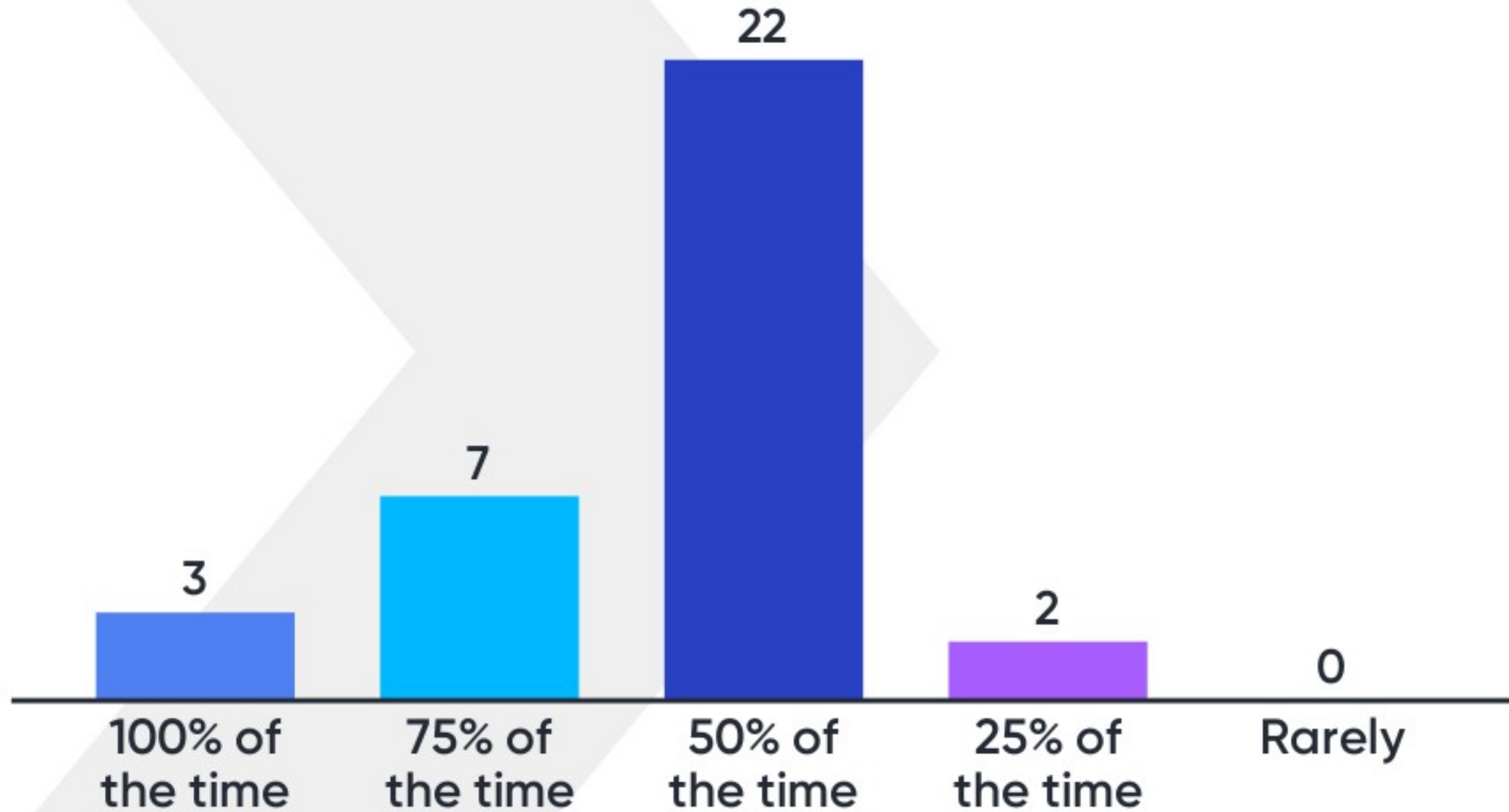
