Notice is hereby given to the members of the Governing Board and to the general public that **on Friday, May 11, 2018, at 10:00 AM, at Scottsdale Unified School District Mohave District Annex, Conference Room A-B, 8500 E. Jackrabbit Road, Scottsdale Arizona**, the Governing Board will hold a Special Meeting and Public Hearing and pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.02, may vote to convene in Executive Sessions. If authorized by majority vote of the Governing Board, the Executive Sessions will be held immediately after the vote. The Executive Sessions will not be open to the public. One or more members of the Governing Board may participate in the meeting by telephonic communication. Persons with a disability may request reasonable accommodations by contacting Ms. Sondra Como, Executive Assistant to the Governing Board and Superintendent. Accommodations should be requested two working days prior to the meeting to allow time for the District to make arrangements for the accommodation.

All persons present at an Executive Session are hereby reminded that A.R.S. §38-431.03 imposes strict confidentiality requirements on discussions that occur in Executive Session. Generally, such discussions cannot be revealed to non-board members, unless necessary to carry out the purpose of the statutory provision that specifically permits an Executive Session. The Open Meeting Law provides for a fine of up to \$500.00 for violating this confidentiality requirement and requires that this admonition be given.

- C. Pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.03(A)(1), discussion or consideration of current Acting Superintendent/Administrator on Assignment at Coronado High School. The current Acting Superintendent has been provided written notice of this executive session in compliance with A.R.S. 38-431.03(A)(1).
