
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Academic Goals


- At least 90% of our students will maintain their highly proficient (HP) status

We devised a survey to get the community's input and are presently meeting to look at restructuring to make our organization more sustainable. and keep our

Interested in the survey results? At the time of this printing, our form is still open, so these numbers may change... but here's a guick overview of what we are seeing so far:

- 86 People responded (59 parents / 18 teachers / 7 others / 2 admins)
- . The majority of responses thought the APT is effectively improving the quality of education and middle school experience. (On a scale of 1-5.5 being the greatest impact - 33% rated 3, 35% rated 4, and 23% rated 5)
- · 99% Agree with our primary goals
- 65% Is interested in having a vote on how our funds are spent
- 81% Didn't know that we had 20 vacant positions on our board
- 53% Have participated (volunteered/donated funds) · 37% Would like to participate, but don't have the time/money
- 56% Read this publication to stay informed
- · 85% Of our parents work


