Dr. Dodds-Keran replied saying that several companies replied that they were not going to participate in the review; because their product didn't meet the criteria that was submitted by the committee. Dede Johnston commented that another factor that companies look at is cost, this adoption is for one small school, therefore it is not cost effective for some companies. The committee would like us to reach out to HMH to find out how many more years Saxon Math will be published; what method it will be published in, and will they consider submitting it for review.

Rubrics were returned to committee members from last week's review. A new rubric was passed out with corrections on it. Committee members were asked to update their answers from last week onto the new rubric. Binders of state standards, mathematical practices and effective teaching practices were made available for reference. Each table was provided Arizona Math Standard Placemats that indicate major and supporting clusters in order to focus their review of materials.
