



Ingleside Middle School 2019-2020

Site Council Minutes

Monday, 10-28-19 at 2:40 p.m.

Members present: Thuman, Kadera, Gonzalez, Spelts, Fuller, Fadeley, Hain, Johnson

- Approve 9-23-19 Minutes – Hain motioned to approve, Spelts seconded, all in favor.
- Review updated Site Council Policy and IMS Site Council By-Laws – Fuller went to the district’s site council informative meeting and had a couple of questions about the by-laws. What is the Continuous Improvement Plan? Kadera and Thuman proceeded to explain and show us what the C.I.P was for Ingleside. After further discussion, we decided to make another amendment to the by-laws. Article II, number five: *The Site Council shall formally approve reviews the continuous improvement plan (CIP) and ~~support~~ supports it on a continuous basis.* Kadera motioned to approve the by-laws and the Site Council Policy, Johnson seconded, all in favor.
- Tax Credit purchases – due to the big enrollment numbers in Robotics Club it was requested that we purchase four additional 2-shelf locking portable storage units out of General TC totaling \$4526.15. Fuller motioned to approve, Hain seconded, all in favor.
- Follow up of 8th Grade EoY Activities – Gonzalez researched other water park venues, decided that if we were to keep a water park route, we should stick with Wet-N-Wild. Kadera to do an 8th grade survey. Considering possible ‘buy in’ options to get 8th graders excited about doing something as a whole class rather their own thing.
- Good of the Order –
 - Further discussing Site Council Policy, it was shared that there was concerns about how major school decisions are made and how parents are involved or considered. Communicating through Site Council when possible big changes are coming and why could alleviate some of the surprise for parents and/or

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community. Sharing the successes of changes as well could be a positive reinforcement.

- Parent had question about how we communicate behavior expectation; answer was Code of Conduct, 'Keeping It Real', and teacher/ staff conversations. Parent followed by asking if there was a change with referrals this year; answer was that numbers have gone down since two years ago, but there is definitely teachable moments happening at all times.
- Fuller brought to SC the possibility of an emotional health assembly. It would be one assembly for the entire school, and if coordinating right, we could share the expense with AHS. She is waiting on date details from AHS to bring back to further discuss if it's at all a possibility for IMS.
- The Leadership Team will be invited to the next Site Council meeting on 12/2/19.

Meeting called to adjourn at 3:41 pm, Fadeley motioned to approve, Kadera seconded, all in favor.
