Old Business:

 - Via email - it was approved for the Library to purchase more books

 - District is already going through Cognia accreditation.

New Business:

- CIP goals (continuous improvement) - Need to be turned in by the end of October.
 - Survey to staff was shared
 - 3 Parts - Current draft
 - Student achievement
 - *Mohave Middle school teachers will increase the think to participation ratio during class instruction by utilizing TLAC(Teach Like A Champion Strategies in each lesson by May 1, 2023.*
 - *By May 1st, 2023, Mohave will increase the percent of students passing the ELA portion of the A.A.S.A. by 5%, as measured by the Spring 2023 A.A.S.A*
 - *By May 1st, 2023, Mohave will increase the percent of students passing the Math portion of the A.A.S.A. by 5% , as measured by the Spring 2023 A.A.S.A.*
 - Culture and Climate

- *Mohave Middle school will offer a variety of clubs, sports and afterschool activities. Student participation will maintain or increase from previous year club and sport enrollment, where 1 in 3 students state they participated in an extracurricular activity by May 1, 2023.*
 - Talented and Qualified Professionals
 - *By May 1, 2023, 100 % of all new staff will have been engaged in both district & school mentoring, and varied instructional coaching opportunities, to ensure the majority of our 1st year teachers feel successful, valued, connected, and choose to return for another year.*
- VR prisms
 - Virtual reality - Mohave is one of two middle schools to implement this
 - Math teachers have been recently introduced to it
 - Each classroom will have a set of the VR tools
 - This will be hands-on
- PAWs/Behavior expectations-back to basics during reading to start second quarter
 - There was a spike in office referrals in the middle of the 1st quarter
 - PBIS Booster week will take place this week (Oct 17-21) where the focus of PBIS will be taught during Reading class
 - New teachers to Mohave have been trained in using Mohave's PBIS expectations and implementations (PAWS)
 - Multiple opportunities for training
 - Of the 13 "new" to Mohave, four of the teachers are new to teaching
 - PBIS committee should have a parent as a stakeholder on the committee
