A quick idea that I shared with the staff to help your eyes . . . the 20/20/20 rule. Look 20 feet away every 20 minutes for 20 seconds, to give your eyes a rest.

- Schools were asked to avoid having families print materials due to cost/availability. May need to re-evaluate what is offered if remote

learning continues, such as additional material pick-ups. For hybrid, physical materials can be distributed during in-person days.

- Not as much interaction with friends.
- Ideas for community building: Kona ice, drive-in movie, parade, etc.
- **Specials: much better this go round. Consider having an outside activity log (e.g. ride bike, run)**
