Please **DO NOT** park and exit your vehicle to pick up your student.


Walkers/BGC/After-School Club members will be dismissed after *ALL* car riders have departed.

Just Food Residency and Household Verification Requirements

Beginning January 1st, 2023, all new and existing Just Food customers will be required to provide verification of residence and household size. Customers will only be given points to shop in the pantry for those household members whom we have received the required verification for. The verification process is expected to take approximately 5-10 minutes per customer. This will be a one-time verification -- after you have completed it, you will simply check in and shop as normal on any subsequent visits to the pantry.

On their first visit to the Just Food pantry after January $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$, each customer will be required to provide the following:

- A completed Customer Enrollment and Verification Form
- Photo ID and Proof of Residence for ALL adult household members. Acceptable forms of Proof of Residence include:
 - Recent utility bill (no more than two months old)
 - Copy of current lease
 - Current Voter Registration Card
 - Recent Bank Statement (no more than two months old)
- Verification for all minor household members. Acceptable forms of verification include:
 - Birth Certificate
 - Custody Order
 - School Enrollment Verification
 - Pediatric / Medical Record
 - Vaccination Record
 - Foster Care Paperwork
- A completed and signed proxy authorization form allowing another person to shop for you (if applicable).
