

News from Fine Arts: Once Upon a Mattress on Stage at GSL


Middle School Auditions Aug 21-22, 3:00-4:30 p.m., Performing Arts Room

Please <u>click here to access GSL's Authorization to</u> <u>Administer Medication Form</u>. This form must be filled out annually for any child who will be taking medication while at school. This includes any scheduled medications as well as any medication such as Advil or Tylenol that you may want the nurse to administer as needed during school hours. Please fill out, sign, and return the completed form to <u>Nurse Janelle Calzia</u> as soon as possible.

If your child has any of the following chronic health conditions or any food allergies, these health forms are also required to be kept on file at the school. Click below to download anything applicable to your child, have your

doctor complete, and please return to Nurse Calzia by Friday, Sept. 1 at the latest.
