



Georgetown ISD Drug Screening Policy

<p>1st Positive Test Result Protocol</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Meeting with a GISD official and counselor with parent/guardian. ● Before participation can resume, student must receive a new physical exam and obtain a medical release from a physician to be on file with the school district. Student must also be enrolled in counseling (see below) before resuming participation. ● Student must complete 6 counseling* sessions within a 6 week period and deliver a clean (negative) drug test at that time. Student must enroll in counseling within 48 hours of parent meeting. ● Student will have mandatory testing the next three consecutive testing dates. Should all three tests be negative, students then return to the random testing protocol. ● Failure to complete counseling and provide a negative test will result in the student being disciplined under the 2nd positive test result protocol.
<p>2nd Positive Test Result Protocol</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Meeting with a GISD official, campus counselor, student, and parent/guardian. ● Student will be suspended from all extra-curricular activities, including travel and competitions, for 6 calendar weeks from parent meeting date. Pending a medical release from doctor, student will be allowed to practice in all practices for the duration of the suspension. ● Student must successfully complete another 6 counseling sessions (12 total) within a 6 week period and deliver a clean (negative) drug test at that time. ● Failure to complete counseling and provide a negative test will result in the student being disciplined under the 3rd positive test result protocol.
<p>3rd Positive Test Result Protocol</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Meeting with campus administrator, campus counselor, student, and parent/guardian. ● Student will lose extra-curricular participation privileges for one calendar year. ● Student may return to full participation at the end of one calendar year, provided he/she has completed 18 counseling sessions within a 6 week period and deliver a clean (negative) test result upon returning to the program. ● Failure to meet these requirements will result in the student being disciplined under the 4th positive test result protocol.
<p>4th Positive Test Result Protocol</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Meeting with a campus administrator, student, and parent/guardian. ● Student will lose all extra-curricular participation privileges for remainder of student's GISD education. ● Counseling will be set up at parent's request.

*All counseling sessions must be completed outside of the student's daily schedule of classes.
