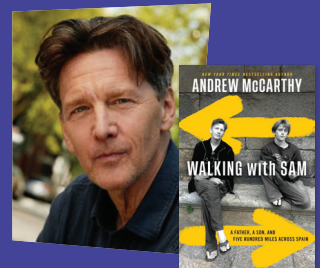

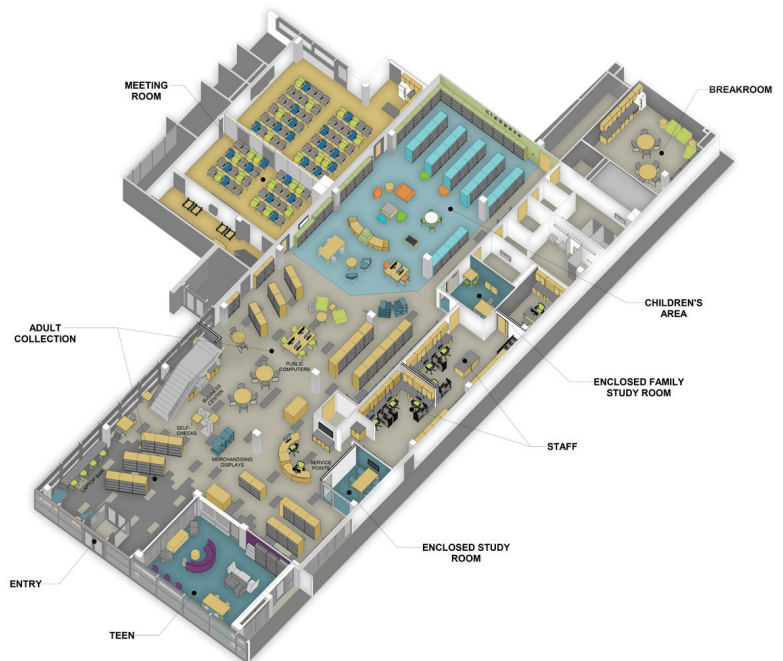
BOOKMOBILE SCHEDULE
