Options to consider for your current 5th grade students for the school year 2024-2025

- Option 1: Choose to remain at FGIS for 6th grade
 - You can indicate this when the Fall Plans Survey goes out this Spring
- Option 2: Choose to submit a transfer to the Spanish Immersion Program at Abbott
 - You can submit a transfer request by <u>4:00pm on Tuesday April 9th</u> (English Transfer Request Click HERE ~~ Spanish Transfer Request Click HERE)
- Option 3: Choose to enroll in your assigned neighborhood school

California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP):

Please take the time to read a letter from the district in regards to the end-of-year statewide tests.



Dear Parent/Guardian:

There are many ways to measure your child's learning. Your child's teacher uses report card grades, classroom work, teacher observations, and end-of-year statewide test results to get a complete picture of your child's learning. Each year, students participate in the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP). Your child will take the following tests, depending on their grade level or instructional program:

- Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments for English Language Arts and Math, required tests in grades 3rd through 8th grade
- · California Science Test (CAST), a required test in 5th and 8th Grade

The CAASPP testing window will open March 1st, 2024. Our students will begin to take it late March, early April.

You are an important part of your child's education. To make sure your child feels comfortable taking tests, you can:

- Explain to your child that these tests are tools to help them learn, and they should not be anxious or scared.
- Explore the practice tests with your child at <u>caaspp.org/practice-and-training/index.html</u> so they can become familiar with the platform and setup of the tests.
- Remind your child that you and their teacher want them to try their best and are there
 to help, every step of the way.

You will receive your child's results at or before the beginning of the next school year. The results will identify where your child is doing well or needs more help, so you can better support their learning at home and teachers can better support their learning in the classroom.
