PRE REQS:

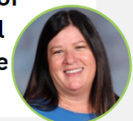

COURSE LENGTH:

One Year

CREDITS POSSIBLE:

6 Humanities College Credits & 1 High School English Credit

PRE REQS:

ACT score of 13 on both reading and English test score

COURSE FEES:

\$30

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

You will complete tasks in narrative writing, argument writing, research, design, and analyzing nonfiction, while learning the grammar and mechanical skills to improve your own writing. Students who pass with a C or better qualify to register for English 2010 or English 2015 at the university. If you are planning to go to college but do not yet qualify for 1010, you should take 1005!

COURSE LENGTH:

CREDITS POSSIBLE:

3 English College Credits & 0.5 High School English Credit

PRE REQS:

ACT Score of 17 on reading and English portion, OR an Accuplacer score of 250 or higher.

COURSE FEES:

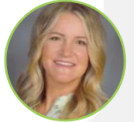

COURSE LENGTH:

One Semester
Offered 2nd Semester

CREDITS POSSIBLE:

4 College Credits: 3 English & 1 Information Literacy & 0.5 High School English Credit

PRE REQS:

CE 1010 with a grade of C or higher, an Accuplacer test of 270-300, or a 29 in both reading and English ACT test scores

COURSE FEES:

\$20

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

You will gain knowledge on how to perfect the research process and complete tasks in research, writing, and presenting digital media. There are three research papers and one annotated bibliography. You will complete a research proposal for one of your papers. If you are planning to go to college, many degrees require this course.

Senior IB English (International Baccalaureate)

COURSE LENGTH:

One Year

CREDITS POSSIBLE:

Only IB - 6 Credits
All 3 Exams - 18 Credits

PRE REQS:

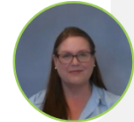
11th Grade IB English

EXAM FEES:

\$135 IB
\$100 AP Lang
\$100 AP Lit

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

- A continuation of IB 11th English (25% course credit comes from 11th grade and 75% comes from 12th grade)
- In house essay 25% + two end of year exams 50%
- You will gain skill in making an analytical argument
- Prepares students for IB, AP Lit, and AP Lang end of year exams
- 6 possible college English and/or humanities credits
