




#### Admissions and Enrollment Process

Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant
 Requirements: First come, first served basis aid, based on financial need

Pell Grant

Requirements: Based on financial need, student can be eligible for up to \$3,172 per semester for the 2020-2021 academic year

 College Scholarships established by HGTC ranging from \$100 - \$1,500 per year.

Requirements: Completion of Scholarship Application, eligibility requirements vary by scholarship

#### Financial Aid and Scholarships

- SC LIFE Scholarship Covers tuition and fees up to \$5,000 per year for eligible 2-year college students in SC. Requirements: SC resident, graduate from a SC high school with a minimum 3.0 GPA, enrolled full-time.
- SC Lottery Tuition Assistance -Covers over 1/2 the cost of tuition and fees for eligible 2-year college students in SC. Requirements:
   SC resident, enrolled as a degree-seeking student, enrolled in a minimum of 6 credits each semester.
- SC WINS Supplements Lottery Tuition Assistance up to \$1,200 per year plus a \$300 book allowance.

Requirements: SC resident receiving LTA, majoring in a critical workforce area or eligible for free/reduced lunch.

SC Need-Based Grant
 Requirements: First come, first served basis aid, based on financial
