Federal and State Grants

Pell Grant

- 2021-2022 school year maximum is \$6,495
- Need-based award as determined by the FAFSA

FSEOG

- Limited funds allocated to the institution
- Need-based award as determined by the FAFSA

SC Need-Based Grant (South Carolina residents *only*)

- Limited funds allocated to the institution
- Need-based award as determined by the FAFSA

SC Tuition Grant (South Carolina residents only)

• Only available at private institutions



Federal Direct Loans

Direct Student Loans (Freshman = \$5,500)

- Loans in student name, fixed interest rate (~5%)
- Need-based and non need-based
- Repayment begins after student graduates
- FAFSA Required

Direct PLUS Loan

- Loan in parent's name, fixed interest rate (\sim 7-8%)
- Credit-based loan
- May defer repayment until after student graduates
- If denied, student may be eligible for an additional \$4,000 in Direct Unsubsidized Student Loan.

Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the single most important thing you can do to get money for college. It's your ticket to more than \$150 billion in grants, work-study funds, and federal student loans.¹



How to Apply

Apply for a FSA ID – fafsa.gov

- Both student and parent must apply
- Use separate email addresses
- Write everything down!





How to Apply

Complete the FAFSA – fafsa.ed.gov

- October 1st
- The 2022-2023 FAFSA uses 2020 tax information
- Most schools will start awarding in January
- May not cover all college costs

Coastal Carolina University Priority Deadline is March 1, 2022.
