FAIRBORN ART ASSOCIATION (FAA) SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Fairborn Art Association awards three \$1,000.00 scholarships to deserving seniors in the Arts program at area high schools and who plan to further their education at an accredited art school or college. To be considered for the scholarship, the following criteria must be met:

1. Student must show a serious intent to pursue a career in art and demonstrate exceptional art talent and skills.
2. Student must be a graduating senior in an area high school (or graduating from home school) and attach a written recommendation by his/her art teacher.
3. Student must complete this application and return it with a teacher's personal recommendation and color photos of art work to scholarship@fairbornart.org (digital submission of application, recommendation, and photos preferred). You may also submit hard copies to the Fairborn Art Association, P.O. Box 1231, Fairborn, Ohio, 45324. Entries must be received no later than April 1, 2024.

The FAA Board of Directors will determine scholarship winners by the end of April. Award winners will be notified by the president or a member of the Board of Directors shortly thereafter. Winners will be presented with their awards and checks during a regularly scheduled FAA meeting. If a recipient decides not to pursue art studies, then his/her scholarship will be forfeited and that scholarship will be awarded to the runner-up in the competition. The FAA is awarding this scholarship as a goodwill benefit to the community; therefore, the Fairborn Art Association will accept no liability with the award process. The judgment of the FAA Board in making the decision is final.
