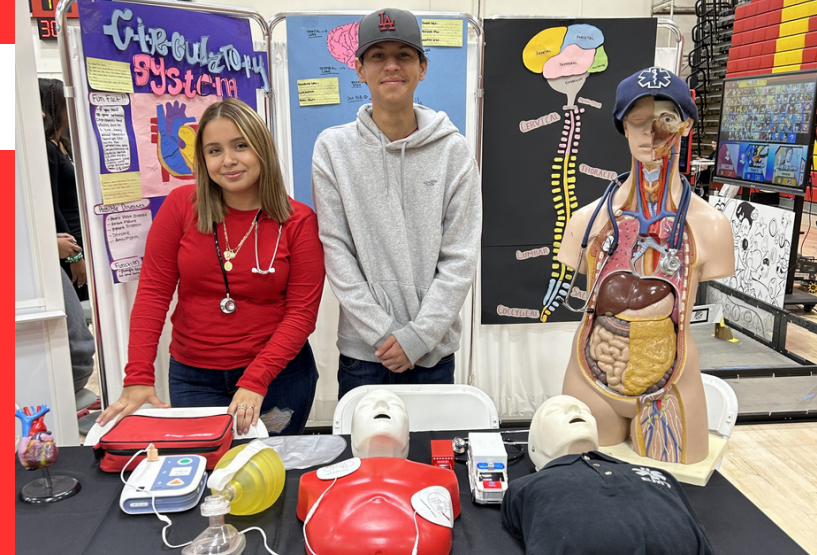
COMPTON UNIFIED DELIVERS ELITE ENGLISH LEARNER PROGRAMS
