Health Requirement Update Recommendation: Beginning with the Class of 2027, students attending Birmingham may complete the Health Requirement by completing one of the following:

1. Health Course – Comprehensive health education earning 5 high school credits
2. Health Alt Clearance – This option covers the requirement(s) listed in the California Healthy Youth Act, but content is not delivered as a semester long Health course. Students receive the required instruction:
 - a. Through a health credentialed teacher OR
 - b. By a certificated staff that has received the appropriate training and the content meets the CA Education Code content requirements OR
 - c. Through other alternative instructional delivery format, provided by a trained professional outside BCCHS, e.g. Sexual Health for America’s Youth Instructor.
