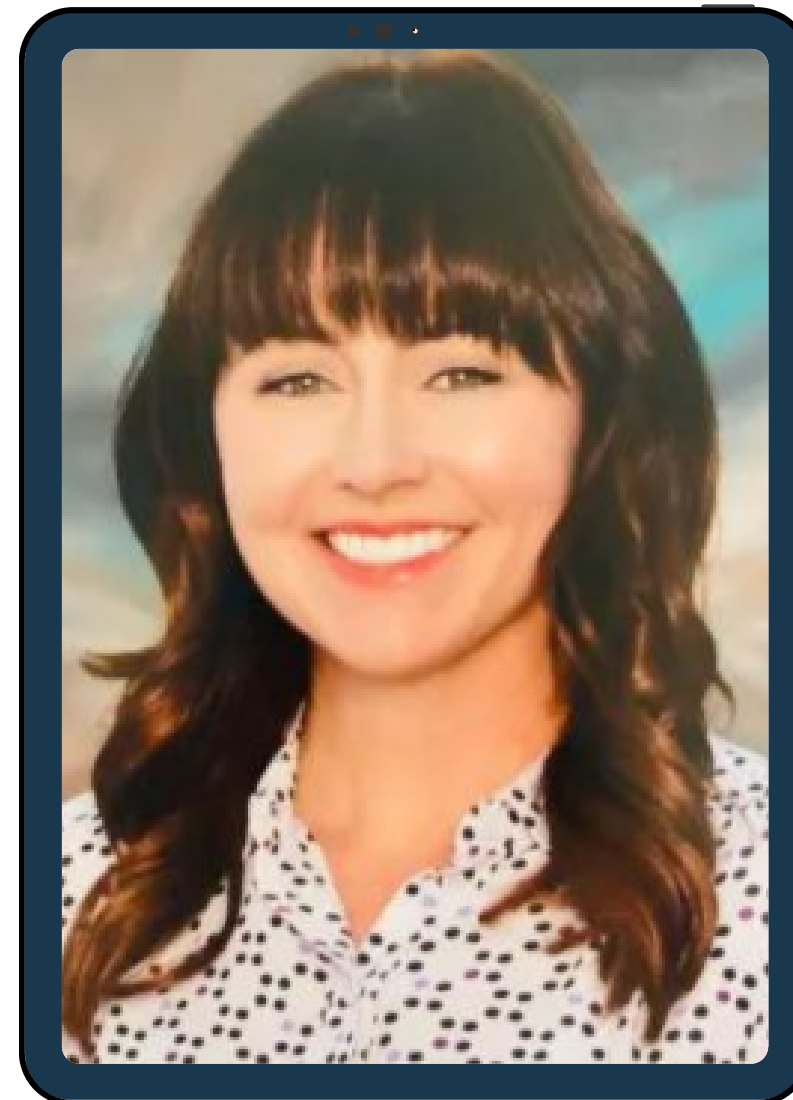

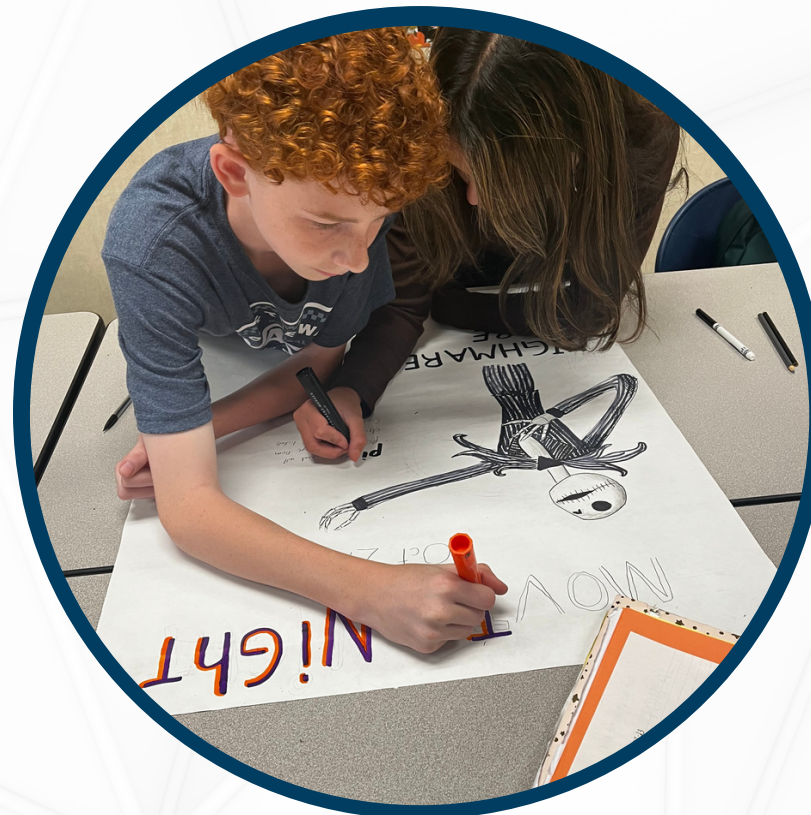


THE ELECTIVE WHEEL: SPANISH, ART & TECHNOLOGY



SPANISH

This is a course that will prepare students to have proficiency in the basics of the Spanish language and culture. This course will focus on developing students' interpersonal, interpretive and presentational communication skills via comprehensible input.



ART

This is an introductory course in art. Students will create original artworks through exploration in various art-making styles, media, and technique. Focus will be given to developing a student's artistic perception and increasing creative expression.



TECHNOLOGY

Using modeling and simulations, students will experience and apply selected basic elements of technology. Techniques of problem solving will be introduced. Students will touch on coding, engineering and more!

- Being a part of choir is a positive way to build friendships in junior high



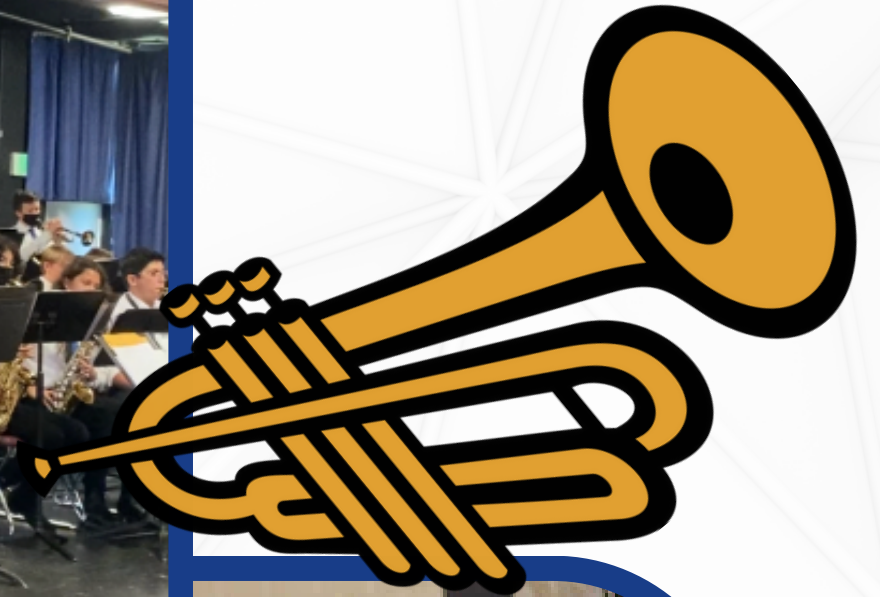
BAND

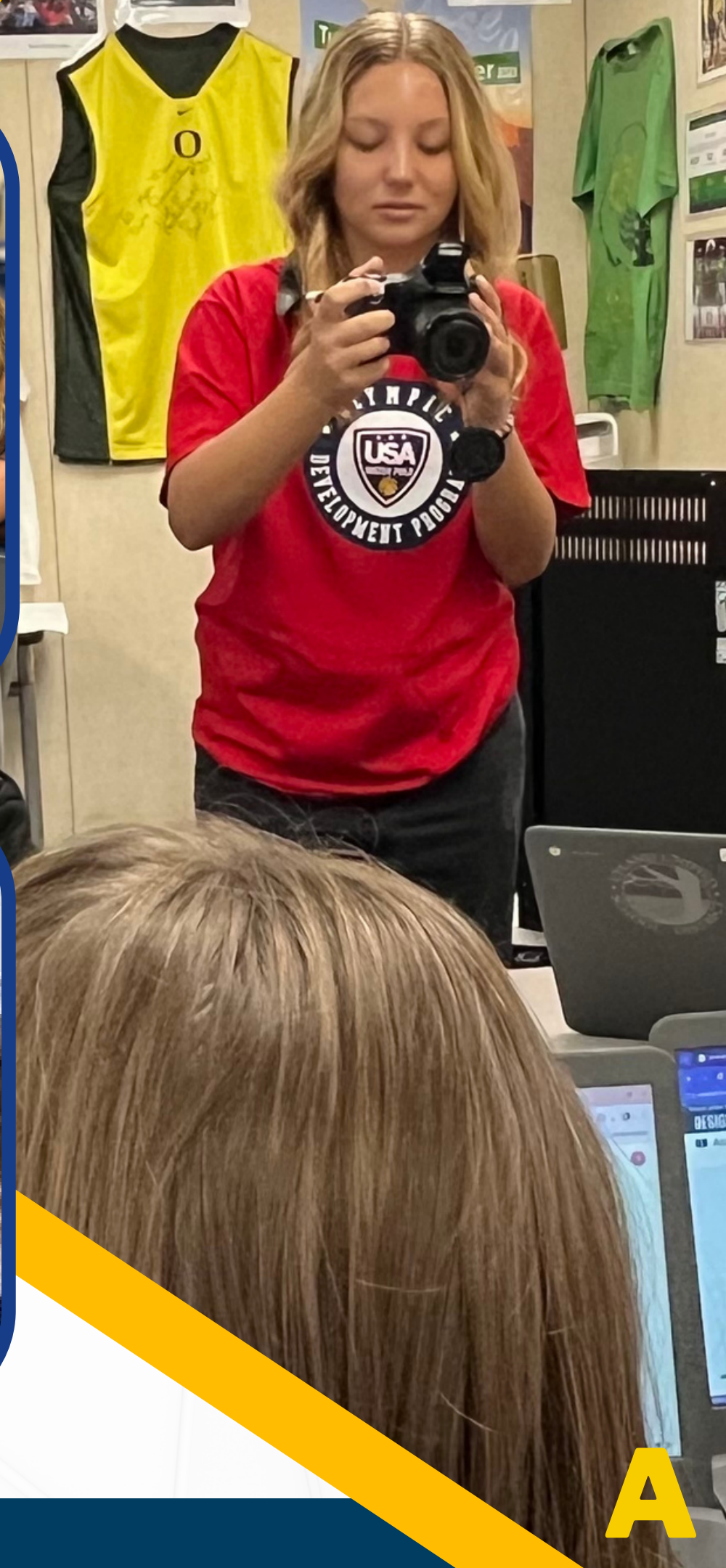
The next 2 electives require you to fill out an application.

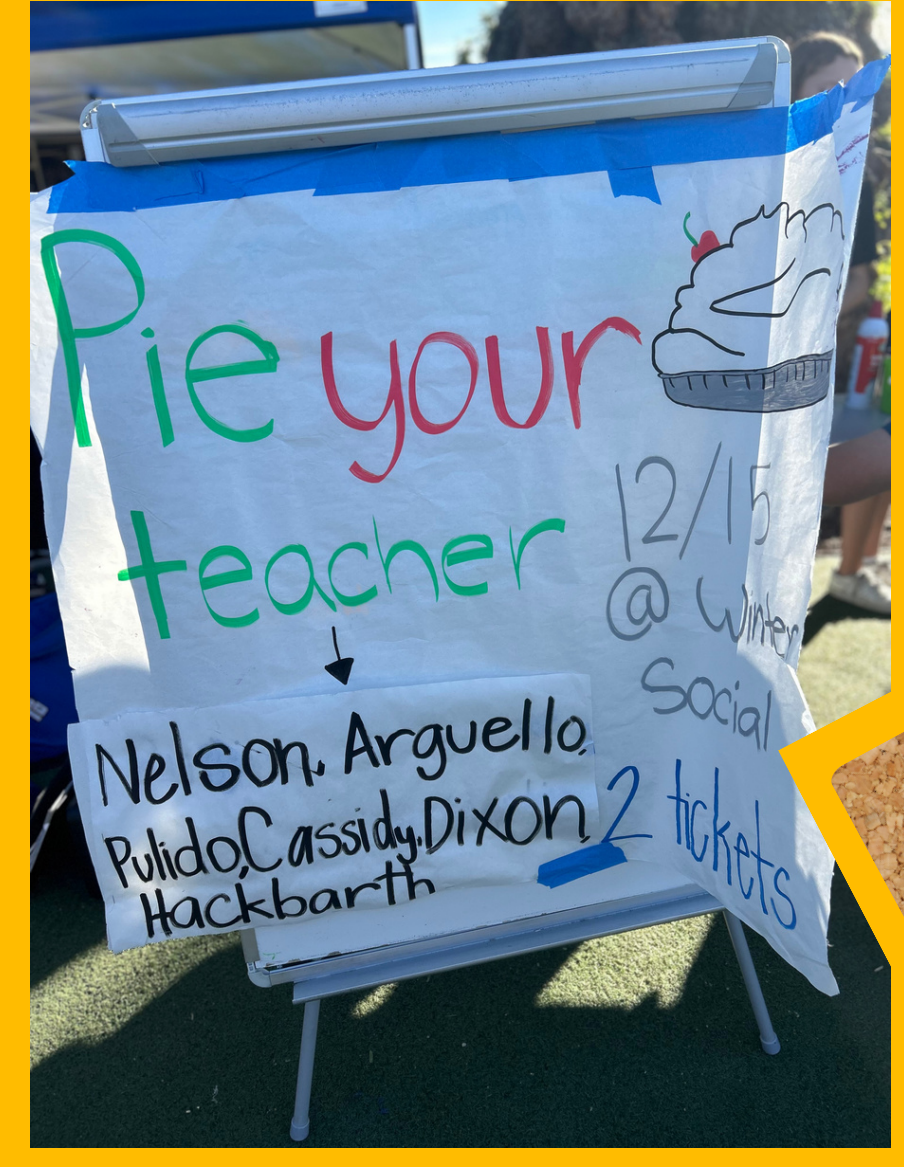

Each 7th grade student is assigned two WEB Leaders

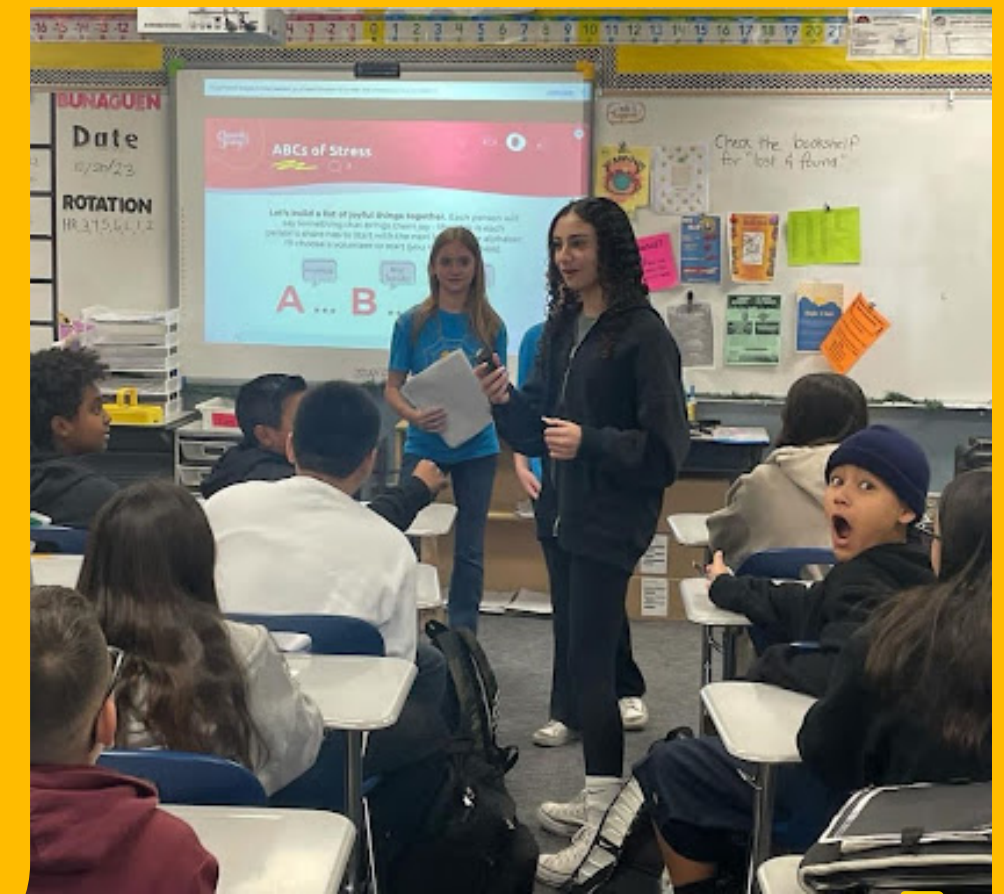

P.B.I.S. / Discipline

➔ **What is Positive Behavior Intervention Support?**

- A proactive approach that supports a positive school culture so that all students can succeed academically and behaviorally

➔ **Pioneer PRIDE** (Perseverance, Respect, Integrity, Demonstrate Safety, Empathy)

- Students are taught how to appropriately act in all areas of campus (classrooms, hallways, locker rooms, eating areas, entering/exiting campus, etc.)
- Every 6 weeks school-wide recognition occurs for students meeting expectations or re-teaching for students needing additional support
