- 8:15am: Students must arrive at the Georgia State Convocation Center by 8:15am. Students will be allowed to drive themselves for the Graduation Ceremony.
- 9:00am: Doors will open for attendees.

Graduating Senior Dress Code

Men:

- Blue, black, or khaki color pants or slacks
- Comfortable dress shoes or clean tennis shoes
- Light button-down shirt with a tie

Women:

- Any color of dress, skirt, or pants with any color top. Dress or top must cover shoulders (no strapless attire)
- Comfortable dress shoes, sandals, or clean tennis shoes (Remember you will have to go up and down stairs and ramps in front of a very large crowd)

Cap Decoration

- For the 2024 school year, Seniors will be permitted to decorate their cap for the graduation ceremony according to specific guidelines. Failure to follow these guidelines will result in the removal of the cap before the ceremony, and the student incurring the cost of being issued a replacement cap to be paid at the time of receipt of the actual diploma the day after graduation.
- All decorated caps must be brought to Senior Clearance on Friday, May 17, 2024 to receive approval of the cap décor. If it is not cleared during this time, your cap will remain undecorated. <u>Administration reserves the right</u> to disallow anything considered inappropriate for the Graduation ceremony.
- Caps cannot contain any advertisement, symbols, abbreviations, initials, words, slogans, patches, or pictures that: Refer to drugs or controlled substances, tobacco, alcohol, weapons, or be sexual.
- Caps cannot denote an affiliation with gangs or that advocate drug use, violence, illegal activity, or disruptive behavior that is detrimental to the safety and welfare of another student.
- Caps cannot be obscene, profane, vulgar, or lewd.
- Caps cannot include numbers other than the graduation year.
- Caps cannot threaten the safety and welfare of any person or make noise. No bells, horns, or anything that makes noise.
- Only the flat top area of the mortar board may be decorated. There may be nothing standing up or hanging down from any of the sides of the cap.
- Students, we highly suggest you trace your cap onto cardboard and decorate the cardboard. In case you make a mistake, you

		 Failure to follow these guidelines will result in the removal of the cap before the ceremony, and the student incurring the cost of being issued a replacement cap to be paid at the time of receipt of the actual diploma the day after graduation.
		 Remember that graduation is a formal ceremony that is steeped in academic tradition. Graduates and their families are asked to conduct themselves in a manner that does not draw attention to them, does not detract from the ceremony, and does not bring embarrassment to Riverwood. Any behavior by any graduate or their guests that is considered by the administration to be inappropriate may result in a hold being placed on your final transcript and/or diploma for an amount of time to be determined by the principal. No "Senior pranks," or actions that do not positively represent Riverwood. No artificial noisemakers such as airhorns will be allowed in the ceremony.

		Colleges, and some career programs, require that students verify high school completion before enrolling as a student and/or registering for classes. In April, seniors will complete a mandatory exit survey. During this time, they will receive guidance on how to request their final transcript through the Common Application or other similar platforms.
