Fact Fluency Through 12

- Ability to recall addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division within 3 seconds
- As students begin learning how to compute with decimals and fractions, these basic facts are crucial to their success.
- Ways to help with fact fluency at home:
 - Flashcards
 - Print "Minute Math" sheets at home
 - Online games and Apps

Math Computation

- Add and subtract multi-digit numbers with regrouping
 - Include regrouping across zeros (ex. 1,000 259)
- Multiply up to four digits by a one-digit whole number, and multiply two, two-digit numbers.
 - (ex. $3,487 \times 8 = \text{ and } 45 \times 38 =$)
- Divide a 4-digit whole-number by a one-digit divisor
 - $(ex. 5,284 \div 6 =)$

Basic Sentence Structure

- Begins each sentence with a capital letter
- Ends each sentence with correct punctuation
- Capitalizes 'I' and proper nouns within a sentence
- Writes a complete sentence with a subject and predicate
- Writes neatly and legibly with proper spacing between words

Grammar

- Identifies the following within a sentence:
 - Noun (common and proper)
 - Adjective
 - Verb
 - Preposition
 - Adverb
 - Conjunction

Independent Work Habits and Responsibilities

- Comes to school prepared with CHARGED laptop every morning
