The Kaiser Permanente Health Equity Scholars Program

The **Kaiser Permanente Health Equity Scholars Program** aims to support young leaders who have a demonstrated interest in pursuing a clinical (e.g. pharmacist, physician, practitioner or nurse) or non-clinical (e.g. accounting, business administration, human resources, marketing or public policy) career in the healthcare industry.

The application is now open for the 2023-24 academic year and students will be awarded in the fall term of 2023.

Program Features:

- Scholarship awards of up to \$5,000 (based on unmet need)
- Dedicated UNCF College Success Coach for one year
- Access to a Kaiser Permanente Health Equity Scholars' Online Learning Community for one year

Program Eligibility Requirements:

Applicants for the program must meet the following requirements:

- Plan to enroll full-time in an accredited, public or not-for-profit, four-year university, or community college, in the US, for the 2023-2024 academic year.
- Must have a permanent address and reside in one of the following states/districts: California, Colorado, Georgia, Hawaii, Maryland, Oregon, Virginia, Washington, or Washington D.C.
- Be a current high school graduate, who plans to enroll full-time, as a first-year college student during the fall semester of 2023, at a U.S.-located, four-year accredited, non for profit college or university; or two-year accredited, not-for-profit community college.
- Possess a minimum cumulative grade point average of GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must have a demonstrated unmet financial need as verified by your college or university.
- Be interested in pursuing either a clinical (e.g., pharmacist, physician, practitioner, nurse) or non-clinical (e.g., accounting, business administration, human resources, marketing, public policy) career in the healthcare industry.
- Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid.
- Students who demonstrate interest in pursuing a clinical (e.g., pharmacist, physician, practitioner, nurse) or non-clinical (e.g., accounting, business administration, human resources, marketing, public policy) career in the healthcare industry.

Additional Consideration Will Be Given To:

- Students who demonstrate unmet financial need as verified by your college or university.
- Students who self-identify as African American/Black and/or other ethnic/racial groups are encouraged to apply.
- First-generation college, university or community college students.
