- Students desiring an alternative, smaller academic environment.
- Students desiring to enter directly into the workforce after graduation. .
- Students desiring to graduate high school early.
- Students seeking a non traditional educational experience with more relevance to their life interests.
- Students interested in Work Based Learning, internships, and apprenticeship opportunities directly related to their career interests.
- Students and/or family who seek a tuition free college experience.
- Students identified as a great fit for one of our programs of study based on their YouScience results.
- Students interested in personal or professional development (leadership training, mentorships, industry training, job shadowing).
- Students who are ready for and will benefit from dual enrollment. This does not mean the student has perfect grades or a perfect academic record. It means they are simply motivated to be successful in a dual enrollment setting with several layers of support behind them.
- Students that are highly motivated to put their interests into action or learning additional skills related to their interests.
- Students interested in the Accelerated Career Diploma where only 9 traditional course credits are required as opposed to 23 course credits with a traditional diploma. After completing those 9 traditional course credits, students begin directly training in their program of study/career field.



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
