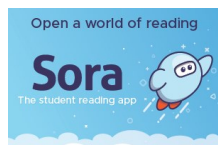

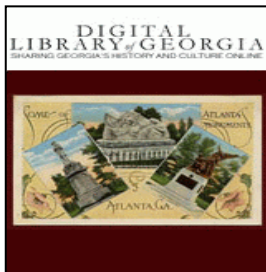
Animal Kingdom

Provides encyclopedia articles on a variety of subjects to be used by elementary students.



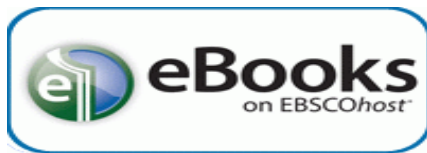
Digital Library of Georgia

Provides over access to digitized books, photographs, newspapers, video, audio, manuscripts, and government documents from throughout the history of Georgia.



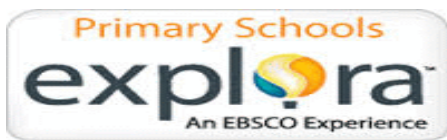
EBSCO Host - Image collection.
