Jesse Joiner was born in Mississippi, February 1, 1931 and reared in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. He is married to Ann Fikes from Hamilton, Alabama and they have three children: Jesse III and wife Kelly, Laura and husband David Steenson, and Chris and wife Carol; they also have four grandchildren and one dog. Mr. Joiner graduated from Tuscaloosa High School in 1948, and subsequently from the University of Alabama with a graduate degree in Music, Public School Administration and Guidance and Counseling.

He has held numerous leadership positions, which include: President of Marion County Teachers Association, two terms as President of Sheffield Teachers Association, member on the Board of Directors of Alabama Education Association, President of Alabama Bandmasters Association, and President of Alabama Secondary School Principals.
