Genesee Parent Teacher Organization Bylaws

Article I – Name:

The name of this association is the Genesee Parent Teacher Organization (PTO).

Article II – Objective/Mission Statement:

The PTO will consist of parents and teachers working together to enrich all students at the Genesee School District. The goal will be to provide the teachers with support and assist in efforts to solve school needs through volunteers and funding.

Article III – Membership

The parents or guardians of students in the Genesee School District, community members and the principals and teachers who are employed within the Genesee School District are members of the PTO. There are not any dues to be a member of the Genesee PTO.

Article V- Meetings:

It is anticipated that the PTO meetings will be held once monthly, with the meetings lasting approximately one hour. At the PTO meetings it is anticipated that we will plan for upcoming events, discuss fundraising activities, allocate funding, determine if volunteers are needed for any activities, and promote a positive community and school relationship to enhance the children's educational opportunities and environment.

Article VI- Other

Section 1. This PTO shall be non-commercial, nonsectarian, and nonpartisan.

Section 2. The name of this PTO or the names of any member in their official capacities shall not be used in any connection with a commercial concern or with any partisan interest or for any purpose not appropriately related to the promotion of the mission statement of this PTO.

Section 3. This PTO shall not, directly or indirectly, participate or intervene (in any way, including the publishing or distributing of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

Section 4. The goal of this PTO is to use resources to benefit the largest number of students possible. At the Board's discretion, the PTO can choose to deviate from this guideline.
