OVERVIEW

Loveland High School is a comprehensive, four-year high school serving the southwestern Ohio communities of Loveland, Symmes Township and Miami Township. Loveland High School also serves career-technical students through affiliation with the Great Oaks Career Campuses.

Approximately 20 miles northeast of Cincinnati, the community is both rural and suburban. Loveland City Schools lie within one of the fastest growing areas in southwestern Ohio. Light industry, local businesses, decreasing farms and ever-increasing commuters to nearby cities create a diversified middle socioeconomic community.

The current Loveland High School building was completed in 1994. Additions have been placed on the original building over the past years. Eleven classrooms were added in 1995. In 2000, 16 classrooms, a second gymnasium, additional science labs and expanded music rooms were completed. In 2012, a new fitness facility was added. The latest renovation occurred in 2016 with an update to the Media Center and an addition of two classrooms.
