## Program Goals

- Encourage positive social skills, including cooperation and independence.
- Develop respect for one's own rights as well as the rights of others
- Develop self-expression
- Help the child become self-confident
- Create an atmosphere where learning can be fun
- Help stimulate the child's independent thinking
- Help develop language skills, both listening and speaking
- Stimulate a curiosity about the world
- Help develop problem solving skills
- Encourage independence and self-control

The Preschool Program was established to enhance the child development courses in the

Family & Consumer Science curriculum at the high school. This program serves as a child study laboratory school and provides high school students opportunity to observe and apply what they are learning in theory. A variety of activities will provide learning experiences that will encourage physical, emotional, intellectual and social development. Activities will include arts & crafts, stories, games, exercises, music, songs, learning activities in math, letters and science and free play. Learning will be encouraged through play and developmentally appropriate activities.

## Enrollment Requirements

The following requirements must be met in order to have your child enrolled in the Pine-Richland High School Preschool Program:

- Child is three years of age by September 1st & toilet-trained
- Provide transportation to and from preschool
- Agree to arrive and depart promptly at designated times
- Agree to submit a tuition fee of \$200 for each session (fall and spring)
- Cooperate with all rules of the school and the teacher in charge

## Our Program

### TENTATIVE SCHEDULE

There will be a fall and spring session during the school year. Each session will be 11-12 weeks, three days per week. The program will begin at approximately 9:30 AM and conclude at 12:20 PM. Depending on the high school schedule our preschool time schedule may vary slightly. Any changes will be communicated as soon as possible.

### STAFF

Mrs. April Dull is the supervisor of the Pine-Richland High School Preschool Program. She is a certified teacher with a Bachelor of Science degree from Indiana University of Pennsylvania.

High school students enrolled in the preschool class will be working with your child. They must be a sophomore or older and be enrolled in the Child Development/Preschool Education Program. Under the direction of the teacher, these students will plan and implement the learning activities.
