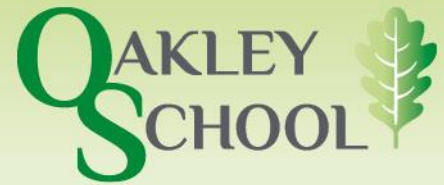

French and Maths Memorable Experiences

Mr Hardy and Mrs Molesworth are pleased to be offering two memorable experiences this Spring term at Oakley, for all of our students currently attending French and Maths lessons.

On the 1st March, Spark2 will be coming into school to run their Brainbuster challenge. This is a fantastic, exciting and dramatic hour-long workshop that will see students work against the clock to complete different tasks. The tasks are designed to challenge all students and try to inspire them using dynamic maths skills. From the tangram to the gutterball challenge each task will allow the group to reveal a digit in the code if successful. At the end of the workshop the groups will attempt to open the case. The more challenges they have completed the easier it will be.

On the 8th March, Onatti Productions will be coming into school to perform Le Château for our students. This is a really fun play written to complement French language learning at beginners level. Le Château is in English and French and is aimed at students up to age 12. It is a short play set in the year 1540 in which a young English Knight has been sent to France by King Henry VIII. He must find a suitable lady for the king to marry. He must paint her portrait and return to England but runs into lots of communication issues along the way!
