Founded in 1966, it is one of approximately 1,600 educational institutes sponsored by the Christian Brothers. More than 85% of students participate in sports and activities, and currently 32% of students identify as culturally diverse. La Salle is especially committed to providing increased opportunities for economically underserved youth. This year 62% of students received financial aid.

SCHOOL SCHEDULE

Students must take at least six academic classes per semester. La Salle is on a semester schedule with seven periods scheduled into two block days. Classes alternate on a 85 minute block schedule. The average class size is 22-23 students and the average teacher load is five periods. The teacher/student ratio is 13:1.
