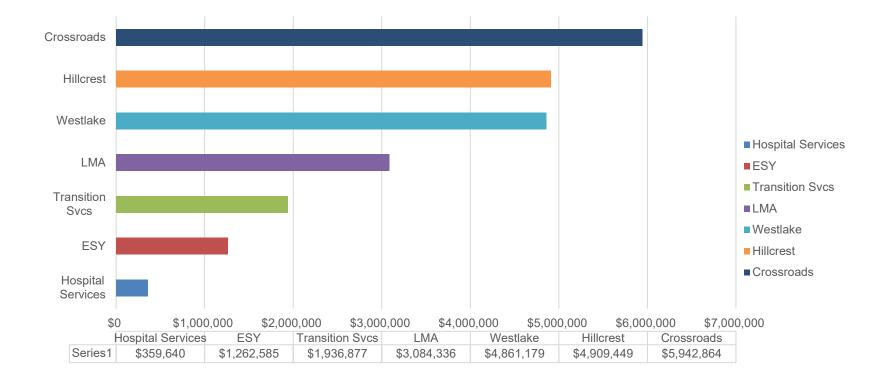

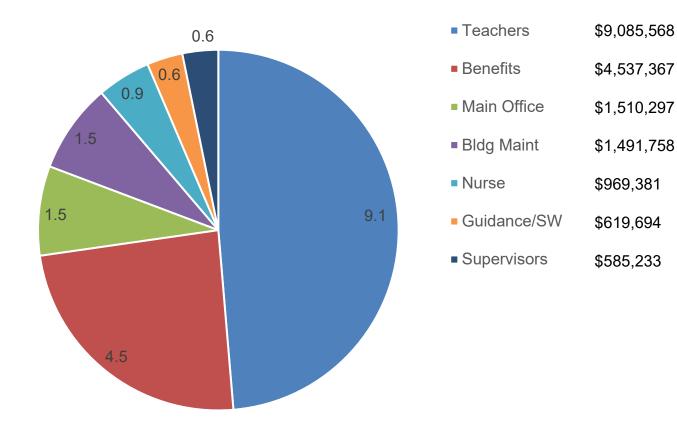

Fund 10: School Budget Details

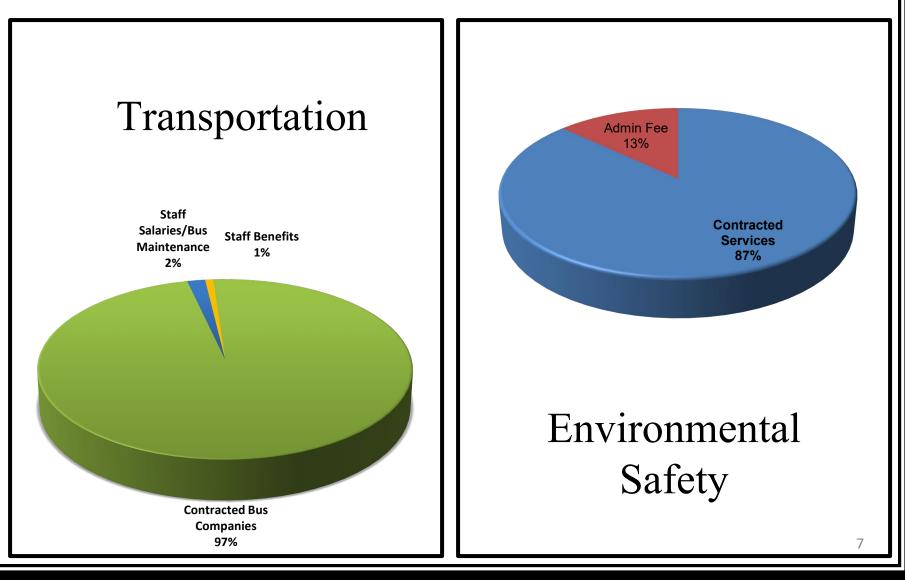

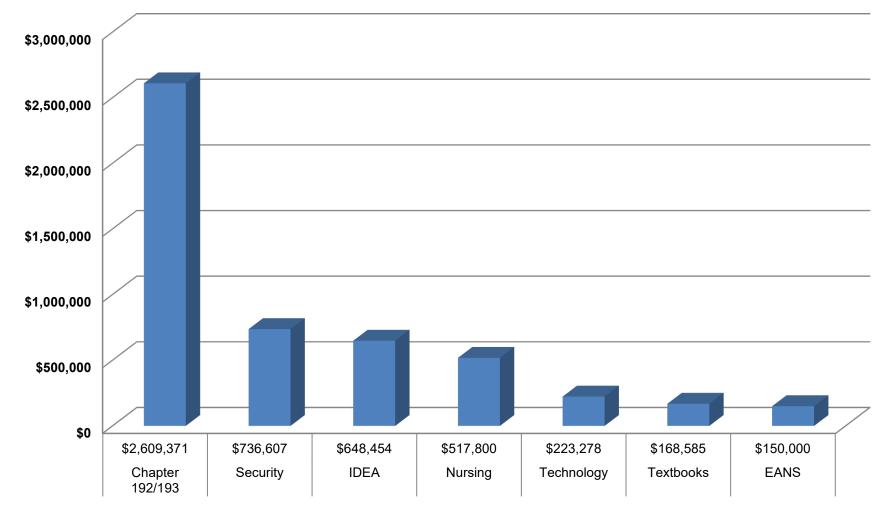
