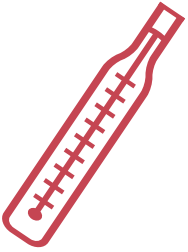
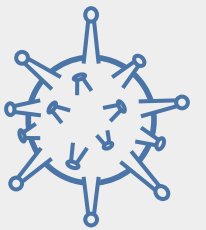

Measles is an extremely contagious disease caused by a virus.



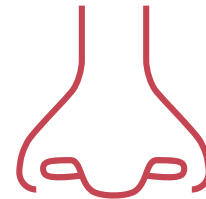

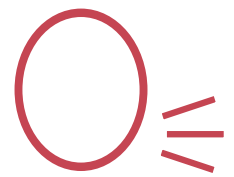

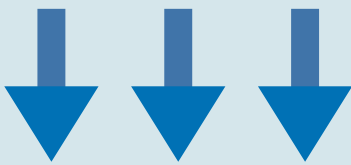

The best way to stop measles is to immunize all children by 15 months of age with measles vaccine (combined with rubella and mumps vaccines or

MMR). A second dose of measles vaccine between 4 and 6 years of age or before starting kindergarten is now required for children entering school in Oklahoma. Adults born after 1956 may also need measles vaccine.
