EDUC 20 3 UNITS

Intro to Elementary Classroom Teaching

CSU & UC Transferrable; Certificate Major Requirement course

This course introduces students to the concepts and issues related to teaching diverse learners in today's contemporary schools, Kindergarten through grade 12 (K-12). Topics include teaching as a profession and career, historical and philosophical foundations of the American education system, contemporary education issues, California's common core standards, and teacher performance standards. In addition to class time, the course requires a minimum of 45 **hours of structured fieldwork** in public school elementary classroom.

EDUC 20 will include 4 weeks of daily fieldwork (SEAL internship) in a LBUSD summer school.

More information will be provided @ LBUSD **MANDATORY ORIENTATION**, after registering with LBUSD and being approved for an internship placement. Virtual fieldwork options (videos) are available for those who enroll in the course past the deadline or after spots are filled.

Teacher Preparation Orientation

Take this orientation course to prepare for fieldwork courses at LBCC. It is a co-requisite to EDUC 20. You must take both.

This course serves as a Teacher Preparation Program orientation and preparation for the Tomorrow's Teachers Teacher Preparation Program. Students who enroll in education fieldwork courses must complete this class. Topics covered will include teaching career pathways, professional educator standards, ethics and professionalism in classroom and school site visits, and skills preparation in implementation of school site visit protocols as well preparation for program clearances.

You can enroll in either EDUC 250 or EDUC 650. They are the same class.

EDUC 650/250 Schedule Note:

This course is asynchronous online from 6/10 to 6/23, 2024. It starts one week before EDUC 20 class to prepare you for fieldwork.

LBUSD requires at least 6 weeks to process SEAL internship placement



STEP 1 Complete a Spring/Summer 2024 LBCC Admissions Application to receive your Viking ID#

- Review the <u>Application Assistance Handout</u> <u>bit.ly/ECIK12App</u>
- Be sure to complete the CCC Apply log-in & LBCC Admissions Application
- If you have not attended LBCC for one or more terms, student must re-apply
- Your LBCC VIKING ID is a seven-digit number (1234567), emailed to the student within 24-48 hours, after completing your LBCC Admissions Application

If you do not have a CCC APPLY ID, please follow these steps:

- Create a CCC Apply Account by clicking Create an Account
- Your CCC APPLY ID is letters and numbers (LBC1234)
- Will be received instantly, via email, after creating an account

STEP 3

Register for EDUC courses via VIKING STUDENT SYSTEM

Students must receive a message from LBCC Admissions the dual enrollment form has been processed

- Log in to the LBCC Student Viking Portal
- Click Student Viking System
- Click Manage Classes
- Click Add by Class Number
- Enter appropriate section number for EDUC 20 <u>and</u> EDUC 250 or EDUC 650 classes
- Click Add
- Go to Shopping Cart to complete enrollment
