Britton, Kuykendall, Miller Audit Report

Mr. Miller presented the audit report from the FY22-23 school year. The audit report was positive with few findings. The school is required to follow the Davis Bacon Act and provide proof of doing so. The Davis–Bacon Act of 1931 is a United States federal law that establishes the requirement for paying the local prevailing wages on public works projects for laborers and mechanics. It was recommended that Altus Schools inventory tracking system include all equipment and technology and that all extra-duty workers have an extra-duty contract.

Red River Credit Union Bulldog Check Card

The Board approved the agreement with Red River Federal Credit Union to continue the Bulldog Check Card which gives Altus Public Schools \$0.05 per qualifying debit card transaction.

Out-of-State Trip Request

Board members approved two out-of-state trip requests. The first was for the AHS school improvement team to travel to the Innovative School Summit in Orlando, Florida.

Mr. Worbes was also approved to attend the National Security Forum at Air War College in Mobile, Alabama in May.
