THE SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$1000.00 for the 2023/2024 school year. Successful recipients must be U.S. citizens and enrolled full-time in an accredited public high school during the 2023/2024 school year.

Minimum Criteria - Applicants must:

- Be a senior and have a cumulative grade point average no lower than 3.0 no higher than 3.5.
- Be recommended by their academic advisor.
- Must also submit a typewritten essay on the topic: how I can/or do help others in my community.
- Must be a 4-year student at Kennedale High School.

Basis for Award - The basis for selection will generally follow these guidelines:

Students MUST Request an Official Signed and Sealed Transcript from the School Registrar that will be picked up by the Official Lions Club Scholarship Committee Member, Students must sign any needed release information for the registrar before the scholarship deadline. ABSOLUTELY NO TRANSCRIPTS WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM STUDENTS!

Application material will be judged based upon Texas Education Agency standard scholarly expectations. The Lions Club of Forest Hill will be the final determiner in each instance as to which applicants will be recipients of a scholarship or whether a scholarship will be awarded.

Students selected to receive scholarship must read their original essay at the Local Lions Club Meeting on the scheduled date. FUNDS WILL BE RELEASED IN 2 PAYMENTS. 1st PAYMENT WILL BE RELEASED DURING THE FIRST SEMESTER AND 2ND DURING SECOND SEMESTER. Proof of enrollment, attendance, and academic progress required for 2nd semester payment.
