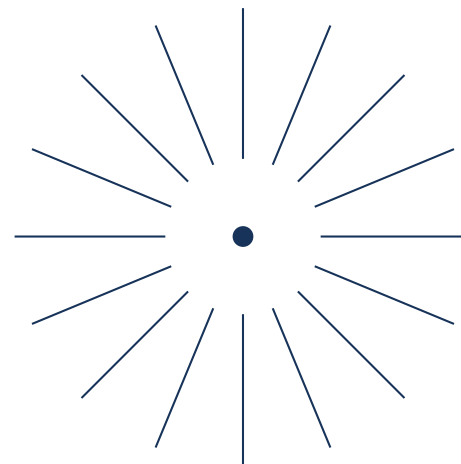
Scheduling Timeline



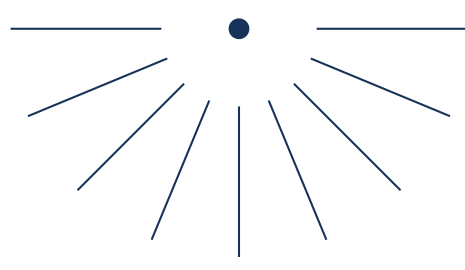
