Graduating from Hudson High School

In order to graduate from Hudson High School you will need to satisfy the below requirements:

1. Credits and Course requirements
2. Ohio State Assessments for 2024
 - a. Show Competency on the state assessments in ELA 2 & Algebra 1
3. Show Readiness by earning 2 diploma seals (Explorer Graduation Plan)

POST-SECONDARY OPTIONS

- ★ Four-Year Colleges & Universities
- ★ Two-Year Technical & Community Colleges
- ★ Military- Direct Enlistment (meet w/ recruiter)
 - ROTC Programs
 - Service Academies
 - For all military options, start looking at the process now & consult with your counselor
- ★ Direct entry into workforce

Making the Most of your Junior Year

- ★ Make thoughtful curriculum selections for senior year
- ★ Register for ACT and/or SAT in the spring of Junior year
 - *All juniors will take the ACT in school on March 21st (no registration required)*
- ★ Review NCAA Eligibility Center requirements with your counselor and coach if you hope to play a sport at the college level
- ★ Put together a portfolio/resume that highlights your involvement in high school
- ★ Begin to write your personal statement/college essay
- ★ Begin to consider which teachers you might ask to write letters of recommendation if required by your colleges

Making the Most of your Junior Year

- ★ Utilize SchooLinks for college and career exploration:
 - Complete Exploration Assessments in SchooLinks under Activities, Assessments. We encourage you to complete “*Find your Path*”
 - Research colleges & work to build your “favorites” list
 - Sign-up to meet virtually with college reps at H.H.S.
 - Track community service hours (community service seal) & extracurricular activities (student engagement seal) through “Experience Tracking”
- ★ Start to coordinate and schedule college visits both on campus and virtually
- ★ Job Shadow or interview people in a profession that interests you
- ★ Attend your Junior meeting with your counselor (Spring 2023)!!


KEEP A HEALTHY PERSPECTIVE!

Exploring College Options

The Home section for Colleges is a great space where you can research colleges and majors.
