



Classroom Support in Primary School

- Provided by an additional teacher or LSA
- 25% = approximately 8 hours per week
- 50% = approximately 16 hours per week (3 hours a day)

Stages of Additional Support

Stage 1:

- A: 2 hours of academic support per week (Literacy/Numeracy)
- B: 2 x 30 minutes Speech Therapy per week
- C: 1 x 45 minutes Occupational Therapy per week

Stage 2:

- Two of the above mentioned therapies

Stage 3:

- Three of the above mentioned therapies

Classroom Support in Secondary School

- Provided by a Special Education Teacher
- 25% = support in subject relevant to student needs, usually 2-3 subjects (8 periods)
- 50% = support in subject relevant to student needs, usually 4 subjects (16 periods)

Stages of Additional Support

Stage 1:

- A: 2 hours of academic support per week - individualised for student needs
- B: 1 x 45 minutes Speech Therapy per week

Stage 2:

- Two of the above mentioned therapies
