> Grade Weights and Grade Point Average (GPA)

- VA= 4 B= 3 C= 2 D= 1 F=0
- ✓ GPA of 2.0 for athletic eligibility

 Cumulative GPA is used to calculate class ranking and graduation recognitions







Academy of Finance

The Academy of Finance (AoF) is offered at all three SMCPS high schools. AoF students develop professional skills, receive specialized instruction with a focus on business, finance, and management, and gain an awareness of the marketable skills needed to be successful in those fields. Students acquire practical

skills via field experiences, and course projects. AoF is a CTE completer pathway as well as an academic academy program.



Academy of Visual and Performing Arts

SMCPS's signature art program, the Academy of Visual and Performing Arts (AVPA) is located at CHS. This academic academy strives to support talented students who exhibit desire and motivation to pursue higher levels of achievement and learning in the arts. Students participating in
