Provided 4,364 professionals (ESE and Non-ESE) with 377 quality, research-based professional learning opportunities utilizing a variety of delivery models including workshops, summer institutes, consultation/mentoring and virtual learning.

FDLRS PROFESSIONAL LEARNING ALTERNATIVES (PLA) RESULTS July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023

FDLRS PLA courses are online courses provided through the BEESS Portal to Professional Learning Alternatives (fl-pda.org) that are comprehensive, high quality, and accessible to all Florida educators. PLA courses are designed to respond to the needs of all students. FDLRS collaborates with the Florida Department of Education, Bureau of Exceptional Education and Student Services (BEESS), to update content, facilitate PLA courses, and communicate with districts to apply in-service credits for educators.

FDLRS HILLSBOROUGH OFFERED 21 PLA COURSES TO 190 PARTICIPANTS IN 2022-2023.

CHILD FIND

FDLRS Child Find Specialist, in coordination with school districts, locates young children who are potentially eligible for services under the Individual with Disabilities Act (IDEA). FDLRS Child Find provides diagnostic screening, placement coordination, training, and support to parents of young children who have or are at risk of developing disabilities.

For children birth-5 yrs. with established conditions or those suspected of having delays that may require ESE services
- ⇒ **SCREENINGS – 1,884**
Developmental Screenings conducted based on data
