DAEP Middle & High School Dress Code 2023 - 2024

Students who arrive out of the dress code for any reason will not be permitted to check in.

Jean

- 1. All jeans must be full-length dark/medium blue denim, zipper front, no button fly. (Basic style with no designs, no designer rips, tears, holes, or ruffle designs)
- 2. No black jeans or any other color, acid washed, stone washed, or light blue faded jeans are allowed.
- 3. Cargo jeans are not allowed. (No extra pockets on the legs or hips of the jeans, etc.)
- 4. Plain pockets No decorative/logo, multi-colored stitching/embellishments on the pockets or pants.
- 5. Jeans may not be frayed, have any holes, rips, tears, or rolled cuffs. No flaps, zippers, or buttons on the jean's pockets.
- 6. Jeans must be the proper size for the student. No loose-fitting jeans. No Sagging. Athletic shorts cannot be worn underneath the jeans. Jeans must touch the tops of the student's shoes.

Shirt

- 1. Shirts must be <u>stark white</u>, cotton blend, crew neck T-Shirts only- No Collars, Pockets, Transparent shirts, V-Necks, or Scoop Neck shirts.
- 2. Shirts can have short or long sleeves but must be made from cotton T-Shirt material and long enough to be always tucked in.
- 3. Shirts cannot be worn inside out.
- 4. Shirts cannot have any visible writing or logos of any kind on them.
- 5. More than one shirt may be worn, but the same rules apply for the undershirts. Any garment worn under the shirts must be white.

Belt

- 1. Must be basic black, brown or white leather or imitation leather. (Cloth or fabric belts are not allowed)
- 2. No embellishments, no pictures, decoration, or designer buckles. (Basic belt buckles only)

Shoes

- 1. Lace-up athletic shoes only no boat shoes, Sperry's, slip-ons, sandals, work boots, steel toes, etc.
- 2. Only shoes with white or black laces may be worn. (The laces must be solid black or white)
- 3. No athletic shoes with any Velcro, pockets, or zippers.

Accessories and Jewelry

- 1. No clips, bows, ribbons allowed. Bobby pins and ponytail holders may be worn as necessary.
- 2. No jewelry allowed. This includes earrings, metal spacers, gages, rubber bands, hanging strings etc.
- 3. No body piercings: tongue included. Piercings must be removed, and metal spacers are not allowed.
- 4. No purses, book bags, backpacks, lip gloss, candy, gum, mints, chap stick, brushes, combs, hats, ear buds.
- 5. No distracting contact lens or hair colors.
- 6. No visible tattoos. All tattoos must be covered, and bandages brought from home.
- 7. NO CELL PHONES

Coats and Jackets

- 1. Jackets may be worn to school during the winter season only.
- 2. No jackets or coats are permitted to be worn in the classrooms.

ID Badges - High School students only

- 1. Current 2023-2024 IDs must be always worn on a lanyard. ID issued only at the home-campus.
- 2. The student's photo, name, school name, grade and year must be clearly visible.
- 3. The ID must be clear of stickers, writing and damaged edges.
- 4. IDs will not be stored daily in the students' folders. It is the student's responsibility.

Discipline- 1 Suspension = student returns to level one and zero points. 1 Unsuccessful Day = 1 Additional Day. 3 Unsuccessful Days = Suspension; OSS, suspension days must be completed; student returns to Level 1 and zero points are earned for 1 period. Students who are reassigned to BIC during the 2022-2023 year will remain on Level 0 for their entire BIC assignment. I have read and understand the dress code and unsuccessful day policies.
