<p><b>Word Search</b> Create a word search using 10 of your words. You can do it by hand, or try <a href="http://puzzlemaker.com">puzzlemaker.com</a></p>	<p><b>Making Words</b> Write 10 spelling words. Next to each word, write 2 other words (at least 3 letters each) that can be made using the letters in your spelling word.</p>	<p><b>Sassy Sentences</b> Write sentences for 10 of your words. Make sure your sentences are meaning-loaded</p>	<p><b>Famous?</b> Write new words to a famous song. Use at least 8 of your words. Write the name of famous song you are using.</p>
<p><b>Rainbow Words</b> Write 10 of your words three times each. Use a different color each time.</p>	<p><b>Word Families</b> Make a word family 6 of your words. Example: Light= Lighthouse, lightly, lightening</p>	<p><b>Exploration</b> Find 7 other words that match the same pattern as one of your categories</p>	<p><b>Wacky Sentences</b> Write sentences using the letters in 10 of your words.
