SME Literacy Night - Family Shopping Event on May 18 from 6:30 pm - 8 pm

The Family Shopping Event is a chance for families to browse the book fair and make purchases. Families can also take a look at their teachers' wishlists and purchase books for their classrooms. BOGO applies to any purchases made in-person at the book fair.

Can I purchase books online?

Yes! South Mountain Elementary also has an online Book Fair from **May 16th - 29th**. Books can be purchased online at Scholastic and shipped to your home. Online purchases do not qualify for BOGO. Go to scholastic.com ► Book Fairs ► Find Your Fair ► South Mountain Elementary Sch, Dillsburg

What is the benefit of buying at the Book Fair?

Purchases made online or in-person during the Book Fair give Scholastic Dollars to the PTO. The PTO uses those Scholastic Dollars towards One District One Book, library book donations and teacher classroom donations. The BOGO fair passes the rewards to the students and families by offering free books.

How does my child purchase books?

Purchases can be made by eWallet through Scholastic, cash or check. Checks should be payable to SME PTO.



eWallet Information

- At the end of fall fair, unused eWallet funds were saved in your Scholastic account as an eGift Card. Simply log back into the account you used to create the eWallet and you will see the eGift Card there. If you set up an eWallet for the fall book fair, be sure to check if you have remaining money left in an eGift Card.
- An eGift Card can be used to shop Scholastic's online catalog or it can be applied to another book fair eWallet.
- Please note that you must login and apply left over funds to a new eWallet for the current book fair. **eGift Card funds cannot be used in-person at the book fair. You must login and apply them to the new eWallet ahead of time.**
- Unused eWallet funds at the end of the BOGO fair will be saved as an eGift Card in your Scholastic account.

Can I shop with my child?

There are many volunteer opportunities available during Book Fair, including a Family Shopping Event. Every class needs 2 cashiers and additional helpers while shopping. Clearances are required. Go to tsu.me/hjpayt to sign up today.
