Finished 2nd in the SPSL North Division with a 9-4 league record. **Won the SPSL Tournament Championship defeating Puyallup 58 to 54 in the Championship game!** They qualified for the West Central District Tournament losing to eventual State Placers Kentwood (by 1 point) and Skyview.

They rebounded by beating Davis 63-60 at Regionals and were seeded fourth (4th) at the State Tournament. They beat Bothell 54-52 in overtime in a thrilling quarterfinal game before losing to Camas in the semifinals. They lost to Davis 70-67 in 3rd/5th game so finished 5th in the State!
