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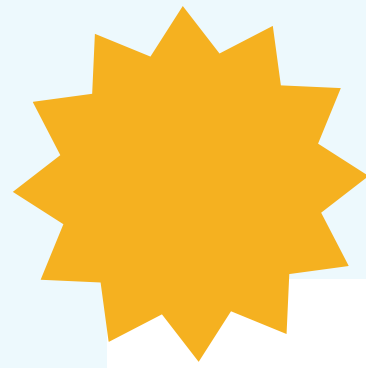
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Constitution



Constitution of the Athens High School S.C.A
We, the officers of the Athens High School body do hereby present, with approval of the faculty advisor of the Student Association, our recommendations for the ratification of a new student constitution. It is as follows:

ARTICLE I – Name

The organization of Athens High School students shall be known as the “Athens High School Student Council Association.”

ARTICLE II – Membership

The membership of the school association shall consist of all the students of the school.

ARTICLE III – Colors and Emblem

The official colors of the Student Council Association shall be black and gold. The official emblem shall be the Golden Eagle.

ARTICLE IV – Voting Membership

The voting membership shall consist of an executive and a legislative branch.
A. Executive Branch
The executive branch shall consist of the president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer of the student body.
B. Legislative Branch
The legislative branch shall consist of only one duly elected representative from each homeroom, club, and organized society within the school. Each class shall have in attendance one class officer to vote on policy to be decided by the Student Council Association. Only one class officer from each class will be allowed to vote on behalf of the class.

SECTION ONE – Consistency

The voting membership shall consist of an executive and a legislative branch.
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B. Legislative Branch
The legislative branch shall consist of only one duly elected representative from each homeroom, club, and organized society within the school. Each class shall have in attendance one class officer to vote on policy to be decided by the Student Council Association. Only one class officer from each class will be allowed to vote on behalf of the class.

SECTION TWO - Qualifications for membership (voting) in the Student Council Association
Candidates for voting membership of the student association may be permitted to seek office on the basis of good citizenship, leadership, ability, honesty, and an overall “C” average. The letter credentials shall be judged by the faculty advisor and an administrator.

ARTICLE V – Non-voting representation

The Association shall have a volunteer council comprised of members of the student body not elected to the designated legislative branch but who want to serve the student body in a volunteer capacity. The members will serve as an advisory board to the Student Council Association as a whole. As members of the association, the volunteer council members will have equal responsibilities to those of the voting members.

ARTICLE VI – Meetings

The Association shall meet at regular intervals determined by the executive branch and the faculty advisor with approval of the principal.

ARTICLE VII – Purpose

SECTION ONE – To develop in the student growing application of membership in a democracy by providing responsibilities and privileges of participation in such a democracy in the school/
SECTION TWO – To promote co-curricular activities among clubs and organizations in the school.
SECTION THREE – To coordinate, lead, and promote student activity and encourage participation on the part of the students.
SECTION FOUR – To stimulate and develop a healthy school spirit, involving loyalty and pride in the school.

ARTICLE VIII – Major Officers of the SCA

SECTION ONE – The major officers of the association shall be the President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer.
SECTION TWO – Qualifications of the major officers

- A. President must be members of the senior class during their term of office.
- B. The Secretary and Treasurer shall be members of the senior class, junior class, or sophomore class during their term of office.

SECTION THREE – Duties of the President

The President shall:

- A. Preside over all meetings of the association.
 - B. Call meetings of the council when necessary with the approval of the principal.
 - C. See that all representatives carry out their duties.
 - D. Appoint all standing committees and special committees.
- The following standing committees shall be appointed each year:

1. Assembly
2. Finance
3. Budget
4. Grounds and building
5. Program
6. Publicity
7. Welcome
8. Correspondence

SECTION FOUR – Duties of the Vice-President

- A. Assume the duties of the President in his absence or removal from office and aid him in association business.
- B. Preside when the President chooses to take part in the discussion.

The Secretary shall:

- A. Keep accurate minutes of all meetings.
- B. Attend to all general correspondence of the S.C.A
- C. Keep a record of the Point System

The Treasurer shall:

- A. Handle the financial affairs of the Association.
- B. Keep an accurate account of funds.
- C. Make regular financial reports to the Association.

SECTION SEVEN – Elections

All candidates seeking office are hereby required to present a petition with signatures of two teachers.
The parliamentary shall be a member of the Student Council and shall be elected by a majority vote of the Student Council.

ARTICLE IX – Election of the Parliamentarian

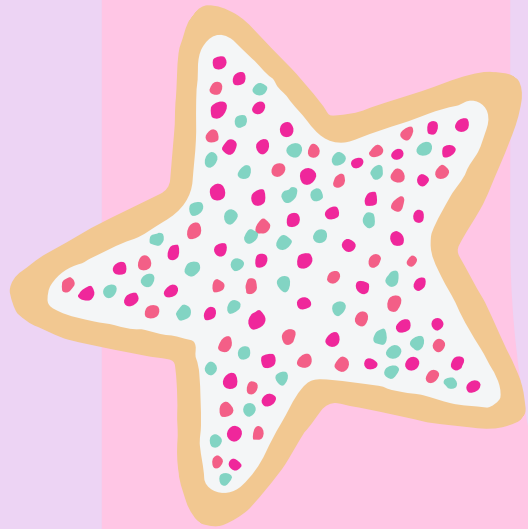
The parliamentary shall enforce all parliamentary procedures at all Student Council meetings and may remove members of the association temporarily if they are unenforceable.

ARTICLE XI – Removal of Officers and Members

- A. All officers and members shall be subject to removal from office for:
 1. Neglecting their duties.
 2. Any misconduct that could interfere with their work.

3. Students found guilty may be removed by 2/3 majority vote of the Association.
B. Any member failing to maintain an overall "C" average at the end of a semester shall be removed from office.
C. If the office of Vice- President, Secretary, or Treasurer becomes vacant, the council shall fill these offices by majority vote of the entire council. Judgment will be decided by the faculty advisor and principal.

ARTICLE XII – Faculty Advisor and Principal
SECTION ONE – Faculty Advisor
A. A faculty advisor shall be selected by the student council and approved by the principal.
B. The advisor shall attend all council meetings and shall act in an advisory capacity.
C. The council advisor shall approve all activities of the Student Council before going to the principal.

SECTION TWO – Principal
A. All new bills and decisions reached by the Council shall be submitted to the principal for approval before they go into effect.
B. The principal shall have veto power of all Council activities.
C. The principal may attend Council meetings and committee meetings of the Council.

ARTICLE XIII – Clubs
Clubs shall meet at regular intervals.
A. Each club shall have a sponsor.
B. Each club shall have a written constitution which shall provide for the following: name, purpose, dues (if any), officers, and sponsors.
C. A new club may be formed provided it has a sponsor, enough members to justify existence, and the approval of the principal.

Article VIV – Socials
SECTION ONE – Homeroom, class, and club socials
All homeroom, class, and club socials shall be scheduled through the school office.

ARTICLE XV – Amendments
Any member of the student body may present an amendment to the constitution. To be adopted, such amendment must be approved by two-thirds of the Council and faculty, by the principal and superintendent and by a majority vote of the student body.

ARTICLE XVI – Ratification
This constitution shall be declared in effect when it has been ratified by two-thirds of the faculty, approved by the principal and superintendent and ratified by a majority vote of the student body.

ARTICLE XVII – Installation of Student Council Members and Officers
Officers of the Student Council shall be installed before the Student Council at some time set by the presiding president during the spring preceding their term of office.

ARTICLE XVIII – Ruling
The Association shall follow Robert's Rules of Order.
ARTICLE XIX – Point System
The system is intended to provide members incentive to give their time and effort toward making the association better for the student body. The system will ensure that members are interested and serving in the best interest of the students they represent.
A. For every service action, members will receive one basic point and after a yearly accumulation, representatives with the most points will be rewarded generously by the association.
B. Members not receiving 12 points in a semester period will be removed and replaced by alternates.

Amendment to ARTICLE XI:
Any officer that fails to accumulate the required number of points shall be removed from the office that they have been elected to for a given term. He may not run for a class or student council office the following year. Should such a vacancy occur, the order of succession shall determine the new officer, provided the student council sponsor consents. Should all the offices become vacant, the student council sponsor shall appoint officers to these positions.

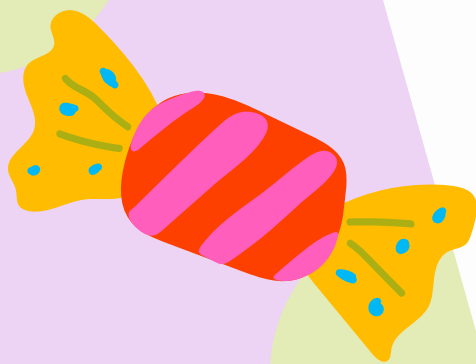

QUALIFICATIONS TO BE CONSIDERED:

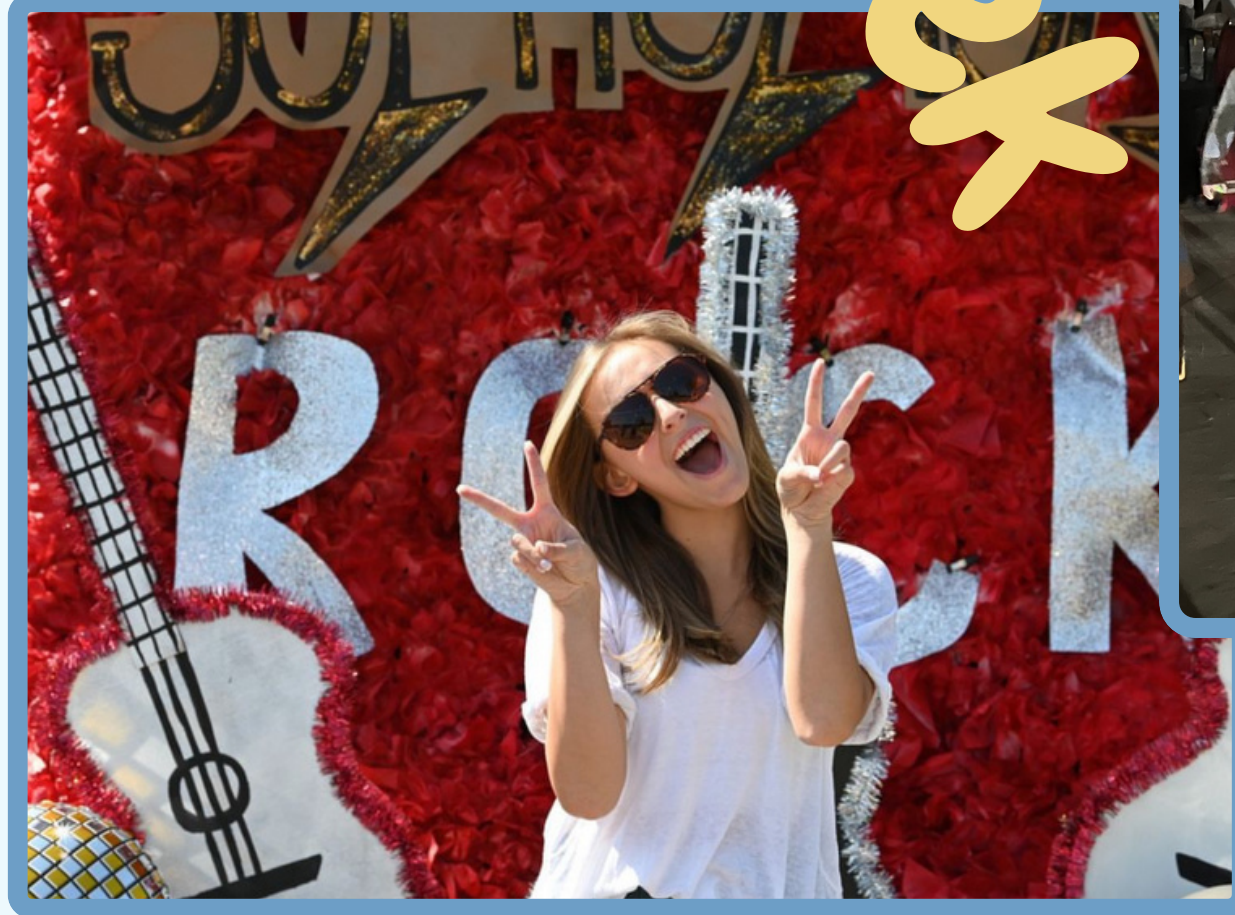
SERVICE- Student should be VERY involved with Athens High School activities and community service activities.

SCHOLARSHIP- Student must have an overall average of 90 or higher.

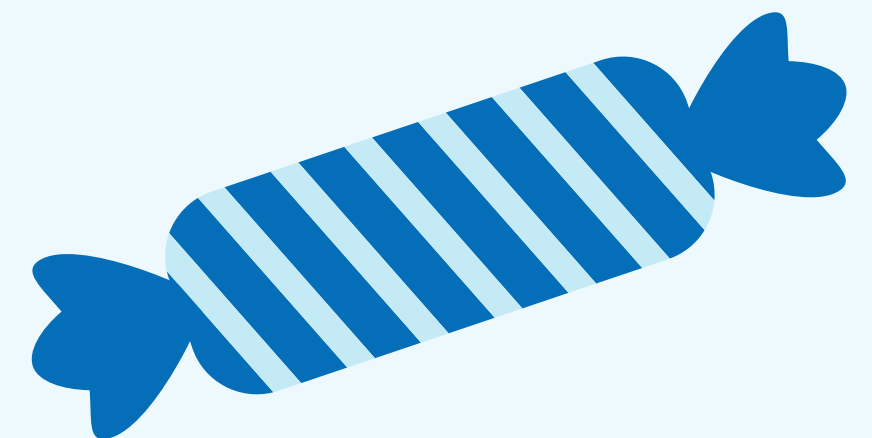

SASC

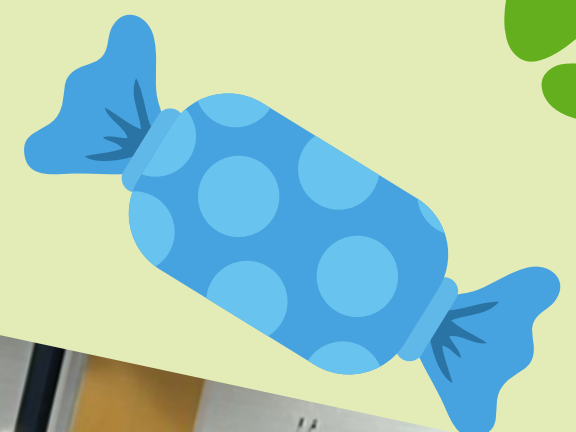
We also won first place in the speech contest, second in digital photography and third in poster!

SOAR Christmas party

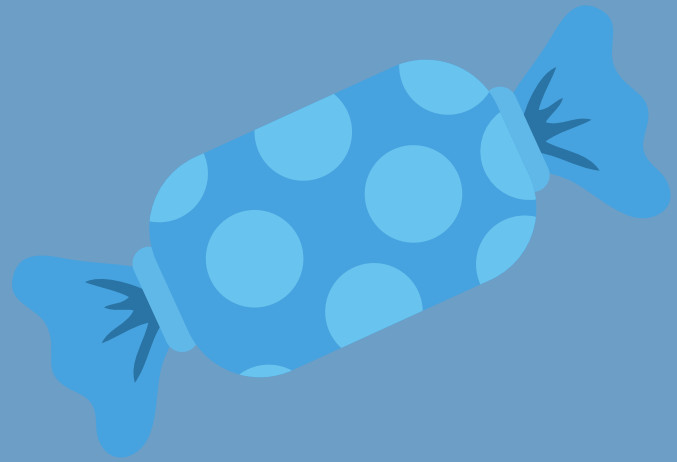


This a party we host every year for all of the S.O.A.R. students in the Athens City Schools District to come together and do activities, eat , visit with Santa and have fun!

Leading up to Christmas we collect and raise money in many ways so that our members can go out and shop for many less fortunate Athens students. We use the money to gift these students.





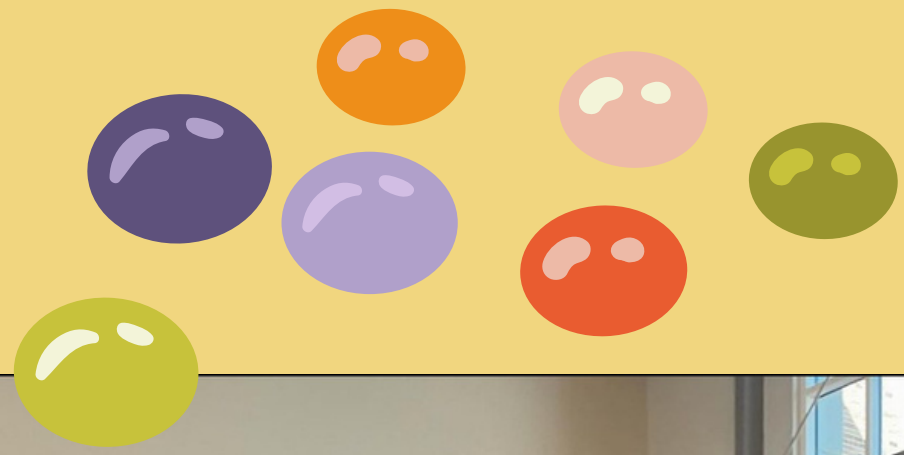
HOMEGOING

We have dress up days throughout the week and nominate boys for homegoing court. One will even win king!

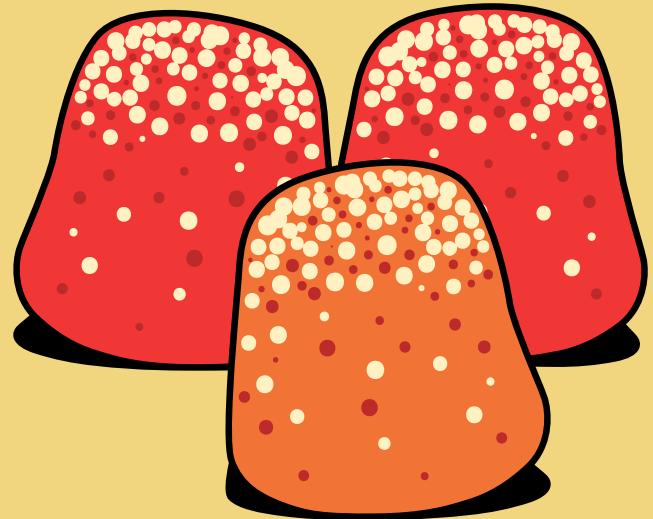
KINDNESS WEEK
