- Sensitivity to the cultural differences between Western and Asian staff and a willingness to work for constructive change in a multi-cultural setting.
- Certification and significant experience and knowledge of Western-style education.
- Preference given to IB PYP and IBMYP and/or IB DP experience.

- Experience with the IB Primary Years Programme (PYP)
- Experience with TCRWP Units of Study
- Experience with Positive Discipline and/or Second Step
- Experience with Seesaw and iPads
- Experience with Managebac
- Experience working in a multi-cultural environment; an appreciation for the cultural differences between Western and Asian staff; a willingness to respectfully collaborate with all staff in order to promote positive change

If SCIS finds the right person, this role may have an additional release period in their daily schedule to assist in Mandarin Coordination. Previous leadership experience is preferred.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- Provide day-to-day instructional excellence to each student based upon IB expectations and the published school curriculum.
- Prepare written daily lesson plans and unit plans and establish clear instructional objectives. These shall be based on the curriculum making use of core teaching resources and supplementary materials and should be available for the Principal to review upon request.
- Provide constructive feedback and ideas for the improvement of student learning in the school.
- Actively support and promote the school's philosophy, mission, and goals.
- Work cooperatively with fellow-staff members and administrators in curriculum design, assessment, and implementation as it pertains to specific grade levels and programs.
- Communicate frequently with parents regarding the progress of their children.
- Communicate frequently with students regarding their progress in class.
- Assist fellow teachers and administrators in planning for school growth and the maintenance of excellence.
- Attend meetings and professional development activities as assigned or recommended.



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- Utilize standardized testing and other assessment data to deliver appropriate ESLR-based instruction to each student.
- Make provision for the special needs of the ESOL learner, and support and promote learning styles, which cater to individual differences.
- Actively participate in school-sponsored events & activities.
- Contribute to after school activities program on a regular basis.
- Attend staff meetings, teacher workdays and serve on staff committees as needed
- Take all necessary precautions to protect, maintain and return all equipment and materials.
- Make provision for being available to students and parents for education-related purposes beyond the school day when required or requested to do so.
- Perform additional duties as assigned by the Principal.
